

No one can measure the depths of his understanding. ²⁹ He gives power to the weak and strength to the powerless. ³⁰ Even youths will become weak and tired, and young men will fall in exhaustion. ³¹ But those who trust in the LORD will find new strength. They will soar high on wings like eagles. They will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint.

Day 1 - Friday, July 1, 2016

Come before God with a repentant heart because He is merciful.

Isaiah 59:1-2 Behold, the LORD's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; nor His ear heavy, that it cannot hear. ² But your iniquities have separated you from your God; and your sins have hidden *His* face from you, So that He will not hear.

Hebrews 12:1-2; 12-15 Therefore, we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares *us*, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, ² looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of *our* faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. ¹² Therefore strengthen the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees, ¹³ and make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be dislocated, but rather be healed. ¹⁴Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord: ¹⁵looking carefully lest anyone fall short of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled.

1 John 1:8-9 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. ⁹ If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

PRAYER POINTS:

1) Ask God for the grace to turn away from what you know to be wrong (apathy, backbiting, bitterness, disobedience, prayerlessness, selfish motivation, ignoring the needs of the poor and needy, discrimination, treating people as being less than yourself, etc.)

2 Chronicles 7:14 if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

2 Timothy 3:1-5 But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: ² For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, ³ unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good,⁴ traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, ⁵ having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!

- 2) Confess all sins and ask God for forgiveness Isaiah 59:1-2.
- 3) Ask the Lord to open your heart and fill it with the knowledge of His Will.
- 4) Pray and dedicate this month of July unto the Lord. Commit this month of prayer and fasting to Him and ask Him to manifest His power in your life.
- 5) As directed by the Holy Spirit.

Day 2 - Saturday, July 2, 2016

Consecrate your life to God; ask Him to renew you spiritually as you wait on Him.
