A NEW THING

DAY 1 - JANUARY 9

Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah. (Jeremiah 31:31)

Morning Reflection

Jeremiah 31:31-34

Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the Lord. But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord, for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the Lord. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more.

Consecration

1. Praise the Lord for ushering you into this new year of gathering; thank Him for the opportunity to pray into it.
2. Ask the Lord for forgiveness for any unconfessed sin; pray for His cleansing power to sanctify you.
3. Pray for brokenness and humility to continually surrender your life to the Lord this year.
4. Ask God to help you seek Him above all other pursuits this year; pray that your mind will be stayed on Him.

Guidance & Direction

5. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you into a closer walk with the Lord this year
6. Pray that the ears of your heart will be sensitive to hear His voice when He speaks.
7. Pray for a deeper understanding of the covenant you have with the Lord and the blessings it holds for you.
8. Pray that God will lead you to begin new things that honour His wisdom and power.

Protection

9. Thank God for His power that is able to keep you from all harm and destruction.
10. Pray for God's covering of protection over your life and household; declare that you will escape every snare of the fowler.
11. Declare in accordance with God's word, that His angels will bear you and your children up in their arms as you continue throughout this year.
12. Pray that every new thing appointed for you this year will not be hindered but come to pass.

Gathering

13. Pray for a deeper understanding of God's prophetic word of Gathering for your life this year.
14. Ask the Lord to increase your faith to reach out and gather great harvests for His glory by this year's end.
15. Pray for a blessing in your finances to start and complete new projects the Lord lays upon your heart this year.
16. Thank God for the blessing of gathering; thank God that waste and loss have come to an end in your life.

Declaration

*Today, I declare that I begin a journey with the Lord. The strength of the Lord is my portion. I am enabled to gather in the harvest. I see with the eyes of the Lord; the fields are ripe and ready for harvest; I see the fragments that need to be gathered. I pick my sickle and I pick my baskets and harvest unto the Lord. I thank the Lord for a great year of gathering in Jesus' name. **Amen.***

HIS PRESENCE WITH US

DAY 2 - JANUARY 10

And the Lord, He is the One who goes before you. He will be with you, He will not leave you nor forsake you; do not fear nor be dismayed. (Deuteronomy 31:8)

Morning Reflection

Deuteronomy 31:1-8

Then Moses went and spoke these words to all Israel. And he said to them: I am one hundred and twenty years old today. I can no longer go out and come in. Also the Lord has said to me, You shall not cross over this Jordan. The Lord your God Himself crosses over before you; He will destroy these nations from before you, and you shall dispossess them. Joshua himself crosses over before you, just as the Lord has said. And the Lord will do to them as He did to Sihon and Og, the kings of the Amorites and their land, when He destroyed them. The Lord will give them over to you, that you may do to them according to every commandment which I have commanded you. Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the Lord your God, He is the One who goes with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you. Then Moses called Joshua and said to him in the sight of all Israel, Be strong and of good courage, for you must go with this people to the land which the Lord has sworn to their fathers to give them, and you shall cause them to inherit it. And the Lord, He is the One who goes before you. He will be with you, He will not leave you nor forsake you; do not fear nor be dismayed.

Consecration

1. Thank the Lord for His abiding presence in your life; praise Him for setting you apart to experience His awesome works this year.
2. Bless the Lord for His voice that speaks to you always; pray that you will be sensitive to hear His voice as you seek His will for your life.
3. Ask the Lord to go before you this year and make crooked ways straight; receive the grace to trust in His leading.
4. Declare that you will always heed the instructions of the Lord and receive mighty victories and breakthroughs as you depend on Him.

Guidance & Direction

5. Ask the Lord to empower you to focus on Him and His glory in all your endeavours; declare that He is the author and finisher of your faith.
6. Ask God to open your eyes to see the plans He has laid out for you; pray for boldness and courage in your pursuit of His plans for your life.
7. Ask the Lord for patience to trust in His word as you yield totally to His leading.
8. Ask God to lead you in this season as you trust in His promises for your breakthrough in marriage, finances, business, and career.

Protection

9. Ask the Lord to protect your business and cause your investments to yield massive returns.
10. Boldly declare God's word of protection over your life; affirm that His word goes before you to oppose every advance of the enemy against you.
11. Ask God for wisdom to fight the good fight of faith; declare that His word will continue to inspire faith in your heart to be an overcomer.
12. Thank God for being your strong tower; declare a season of complete protection from sickness and all the works of darkness.

Gathering

13. Ask God to lead you to the people you are called to, to speak the gospel to, that they may be drawn to the Lord.
14. Ask the Lord for a revival across the nations; thank Him that every barrier standing against the propagation of the gospel is broken.
15. Pray for a massive financial breakthrough for the body of Christ, to establish new churches among the unreached people groups of the world.
16. Commit the body of Christ to God and pray, that the church will identify and develop innovative ways to reach the unsaved.

Declaration

*God's presence is my portion; He abides with me wherever I go according to His promise. I receive the grace to succeed in every area of my life. I declare every limitation over my family is broken in Jesus' name. I declare that doors of good health, financial blessings, and prosperity open to me because He is with me. In Jesus' name. **Amen!***

HIS SURE PROMISE

DAY 3 - JANUARY 11

Not a word failed of any good thing which the LORD had spoken to the house of Israel. All came to pass. (Joshua 21:45)

Morning Reflection

Joshua 21:40-45

So all the cities for the children of Merari according to their families, the rest of the families of the Levites, were by their lot twelve cities. All the cities of the Levites within the possession of the children of Israel were forty-eight cities with their common-lands. Every one of these cities had its common-land surrounding it; thus were all these cities. So the Lord gave to Israel all the land of which He had sworn to give to their fathers, and they took possession of it and dwelt in it. The Lord gave them rest all around, according to all that He had sworn to their fathers. And not a man of all their enemies stood against them; the Lord delivered all their enemies into their hand. Not a word failed of any good thing which the Lord had spoken to the house of Israel. All came to pass.

Consecration

1. Celebrate the Lord's faithfulness; thank Him that in this season of consecration, you shall see the manifestation of His promises.
2. Surrender your desires to the Lord and ask Him to purge you of any sin that hinders your commitment to Him.
3. Commit yourself to the Lord and ask Him to help you to walk in His ways at all times.
4. Dedicate your life to the Lord and ask Him to give you a heart that is totally sold out to His service.

Guidance & Direction

5. Thank God for the presence of the Holy Spirit in your life; ask Him to order your steps towards the fulfilment of your destiny.
6. Submit your thoughts and ideas to the Lord and ask Him to help you make decisions that align with His purpose for your life.
7. Pray for God's wisdom and a heart of discernment to follow His counsel in all situations.
8. Ask the Lord for grace to trust and depend on Him alone for direction in all you do.

Protection

9. Plead the blood of Jesus over you and your household; declare you are delivered from harm's way.
10. Ask the Lord to uphold you with His right hand and preserve all that concerns you.
11. By faith, resist every assignment of the enemy against your harvest in this season.
12. Commit your life, business, and career to the Lord; ask Him to be your shield and buckler.

Gathering

13. Ask the Lord to use you as an instrument of change in your community and to draw many to Himself.
14. Ask the Lord to anoint believers afresh and stir in their hearts a renewed zeal toward service in His house.
15. Pray that the heart of people will be opened to receive the word and set them free from the bondage of sin.
16. Pray that believers will be empowered to do exploits and to reach out to the unsaved and broken.

Declaration

*I will praise God for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. I believe in His sure promises and declare that I shall fulfill His purpose for my life. By the confident declaration of His word, I triumph over every challenge that confronts me. In Jesus name. **Amen!***

PREPARE TO POSSESS

DAY 4 - JANUARY 12

Pass through the camp and command the people, saying, Prepare provisions for yourselves, for within three days you will cross over this Jordan, to go in to possess the land which the Lord your God is giving you to possess. (Joshua 1:11)

Morning Reflection

Joshua 1:10-18

Then Joshua commanded the officers of the people, saying, Pass through the camp and command the people, saying, Prepare provisions for yourselves, for within three days you will cross over this Jordan, to go in to possess the land which the Lord your God is giving you to possess. And to the Reubenites, the Gadites, and half the tribe of Manasseh Joshua spoke, saying, Remember the word which Moses the servant of the Lord commanded you, saying, The Lord your God is giving you rest and is giving you this land. Your wives, your little ones, and your livestock shall remain in the land which Moses gave you on this side of the Jordan. But you shall pass before your brethren armed, all your mighty men of valor, and help them, until the Lord has given your brethren rest, as He gave you, and they also have taken possession of the land which the Lord your God is giving them. Then you shall return to the land of your possession and enjoy it, which Moses the Lord's servant gave you on this side of the Jordan toward the sunrise. So they answered Joshua, saying, All that you command us we will do, and wherever you send us we will go. Just as we heeded Moses in all things, so we will heed you. Only the Lord your God be with you, as He was with Moses. Whoever rebels against your command and does not heed your words, in all that you command him, shall be put to death. Only be strong and of good courage.

Consecration

1. Bless the Lord for being the One who satisfies you with good things and establishes you with great possessions.
2. Consecrate yourself to the Lord and ask Him to deliver you from evil and negative influences on your paths.
3. Ask the Lord to strengthen each member of your family with might in their inner man to wrestle and possess all He has provided for them.
4. Receive the grace to continually yield to the Holy Spirit; declare that you will live to please God.

Guidance & Direction

5. Thank God for the blessing to live for Christ and to walk in the paths of righteousness.
6. Ask the Lord to lead you in your pursuits as you abide in His presence daily during these 21 days of prayer.
7. Ask the Lord to open your eyes to see His promises of provision in His word; pray for faith to believe and claim them.
8. Ask the Lord to use your life and testimony to inspire others to pray and seek the face of the Lord.

Protection

9. Command every evil force of oppression and suppression in your life to be broken, in Jesus' name.
10. Command every challenging situation in your family to be lifted in Jesus name; declare that a new season of God's deliverance and restoration.
11. Mark every child in your family with the blood of Jesus; declare every plot of wickedness against their lives to fails, in Jesus name.
12. Thank God for His sovereignty and power over every situation in your life; praise Him that, what the enemy meant for evil will turn out for your good.

Gathering

13. Declare Gods word that you are possessing every land the Lord has given you to possess in this season; celebrate Gods victory in your life.
14. Pray for Gods grace to end every association and relationship that brings wastage and loss in your life.
15. Declare the blessing of a thousand times more than your fathers over the works of your hands.
16. Declare over your family and loved ones that they will gather many baskets in various areas of their lives this year.

Declaration

*I declare that my steps are ordered by the Lord therefore, He is leading me into godly associations that strengthen my faith. I have the spirit of discernment and I will be sensitive to the promptings of the Holy Spirit in me. By the grace and wisdom of God, I overcome every indebtedness and I walk in financial freedom. I will possess my possessions in Jesus' name.
Amen.*

DREAM BIG

DAY 5 - JANUARY 13

I am the Lord your God, Who brought you out of the land of Egypt; Open your mouth wide, and I will fill it. (Psalm 81:10)

Morning Reflection

Psalms 81:8-12

Hear, O My people, and I will admonish you!

O Israel, if you will listen to Me!

There shall be no foreign god among you;

Nor shall you worship any foreign god.

I am the LORD your God,

Who brought you out of the land of Egypt;

Open your mouth wide, and I will fill it.

But My people would not heed My voice,

And Israel would have none of Me.

So I gave them over to their own stubborn heart,

To walk in their own counsels.

Consecration

1. Celebrate the Lord for setting you on paths of righteousness and godliness that leads to life and prosperity.
2. Ask God for enablement to overcome the temptations the enemy brings your way to live a life of sin.
3. Ask God to give you a renewed love to hear and obey His instructions.
4. Thank God that as you consecrate yourself in prayer, the eyes of your heart will be opened to see God's great plans for your life.

Guidance & Direction

5. Thank God for the assurance that He will never leave you nor forsake you.
6. Commit your desires and plans to God's hands and ask Him to guide you to achieve them.
7. Ask God to grant you wisdom, knowledge, and understanding to bring your ideas and solutions into reality.
8. Ask the Lord for renewed strength to excel and shine as a light of the world; declare that you will be an example as you dream big and accomplish them.

Protection

9. Ask God to guide you from making decisions that will bring harm to your life and family.
10. Pray for grace to remain focused on what God has set before you; declare that you will not be distracted by any wile of the enemy.
11. Pray for confidence to venture into new territories; declare that you will leap over every wall.
12. Ask God to scatter the assembly of wicked and evil men that stand opposed to the growth and progress of you and your family.

Gathering

13. Ask God to give the church wisdom to gather a plentiful harvest of souls for His Kingdom.
14. Pray that every seed committed into your hands will not die but grow and yield a fruitful harvest.
15. Ask God to empower leaders of your country with clarity of purpose, and wisdom to grow the wealth of the nation for her people.
16. Ask God to enable you to find and possess the resources you need to achieve great things in your life this year.

Declaration

*Father in Heaven, I set myself apart unto You. I have the righteousness of God in Christ and I have the mind of Christ also. My heart is set on things above. I declare that I am walking into my blessings. I overcome everything that limits me. As I dream a thing, I possess it. My Father shows me the way I must take to possess my possessions, in Jesus' name. **Amen***

LAUNCH OUT

DAY 6 – JANUARY 14

When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch. But Simon answered and said to Him, Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless at Your word I will let down the net. (Luke 5:4-5)

Morning Reflection

Luke 5:1-7

So it was, as the multitude pressed about Him to hear the word of God, that He stood by the Lake of Gennesaret, and saw two boats standing by the lake; but the fishermen had gone from them and were washing their nets. Then He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little from the land. And He sat down and taught the multitudes from the boat. When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch. But Simon answered and said to Him, Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless at Your word I will let down the net. And when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was breaking. So they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink.

Consecration

1. Thank God for saving you and giving you His Spirit to indwell you.
2. Ask the Lord for a heart of humility; thank Him for grace to obey His word to launch out for a catch.
3. Ask God to help you live a life above reproach to honour Him.
4. Surrender your gifts and abilities to the Lord and ask Him to lead you to use them to build His kingdom.

Guidance & Direction

5. Thank the Lord for His unfailing love and grace at work in your life to help you live as Christ lived.
6. Ask the Lord for the discernment to know where and when to invest the resources He has blessed you with.
7. Ask God to guide you continually as you seek breakthroughs in your life this year.
8. Pray for a heart of faith to respond to God's voice as He speaks and guides you.

Protection

9. Pray and break free from the spirit of stagnation in your life; declare that you'll continually change and become better in all aspects of your life each month of this year.
10. Condemn every voice of failure and defeat oppressing you; declare that you will meditate on God's words of victory only.
11. Decree that every crooked path on your way to elevation is made straight in Jesus name.

12. Ask the Lord to remove every hindrance to your miracles this year; declare that you will fulfil destiny.

Gathering

13. Ask the Lord for wisdom to minister God's love to the broken and crushed at heart in your life.
14. Pray for a release of favour for an uncommon harvest into God's family; decree fruitfulness and success in every evangelistic effort in Jesus name.
15. Overturn every word of unfruitfulness and declare that you will be fruitful in all your endeavours this year.
16. Declare that your nets and your boats will be filled to overflowing this year in Jesus name.

Declaration

*I declare that I will testify of God's goodness this year. I will walk daily with the Lord and I will bear fruit as I obey His word. My family and I will be like a well-watered garden. We will experience divine encounters that will bring joy and gladness. In Jesus' name. **Amen!***

DECREE A THING

DAY 7 - JANUARY 15

*You will also declare a thing, And it will be established for you; So light will shine on your ways.
(Job 22:28)*

Morning Reflection

Job 22:21-29

Now acquaint yourself with Him, and be at peace; Thereby good will come to you. Receive, please, instruction from His mouth, And lay up His words in your heart. If you return to the Almighty, you will be built up; You will remove iniquity far from your tents. Then you will lay your gold in the dust, And the gold of Ophir among the stones of the brooks. Yes, the Almighty will be your gold and your precious silver; For then you will have your delight in the Almighty, And lift up your face to God. You will make your prayer to Him, He will hear you, And you will pay your vows. You will also declare a thing, And it will be established for you; So light will shine on your ways. When they cast you down, and you say, Exaltation will come! Then He will save the humble person.

Consecration

1. Bless the Lord for granting you the authority in His name to decree a thing and see it established.
2. Submit your thoughts to the Lord and ask Him to help you renew your mind to conform to His divine will and purpose.
3. Consecrate your lips and tongue to the Lord; pray that you will not transgress against the Lord or His word by the words you speak.
4. Declare that every utterance that you will make today over your life and family will honour the Lord.

Guidance & Direction

5. Thank the Lord for ordaining strength in your words to plant righteousness and to uproot every form of evil.
6. Declare that the Lord is your light and your salvation; ask Him to guide you in all your ways.
7. Ask the Lord to lead you to the fulfilment of all His plans concerning your life.
8. Ask the Lord for grace to remain focused as you seek Him to establish His will in your life and family.

Protection

9. Declare that you and your household are protected by the blood of Jesus against any demonic power.
10. Ask the Lord for His supernatural covering over all your activities and plans for this year.
11. Pray for all ministers of the Gospel in ICGC and the body of Christ; ask for God's preservation from every arrow of the wicked against them.
12. Declare that in this year, everything that is meant to cast you down shall turn around for your lifting.

Gathering

13. Pray that by the work of the Spirit of God through believers, there will be a supernatural gathering of souls into the kingdom of God.
14. Ask the Lord to establish every increase of souls in His house in Jesus name!
15. Ask the Lord for wisdom to preserve the blessings He gives you this year of gathering and beyond.
16. Declare that every form of evil designed to scatter what we gather will not succeed.

Declaration

*I boldly declare that this is the year that the Lord has made for my uplifting. All things are working together for my good. I receive the power of God to accomplish extraordinary things for His glory. I declare that my words and prayers are fruitful and produce mighty results. In Jesus' name! **Amen.***
