A GLORIOUS END

DAY 15 - JANUARY 23

The end of a thing is better than its beginning; The patient in spirit is better than the proud in spirit. (Ecclesiastes 7:8)

Morning Reflection

Ecclesiastes 7:8-10

The end of a thing is better than the beginning; the patient in spirit is better than the proud in spirit. Do not hasten in your spirit to be angry, for anger rests in the bosom of fools. Do not say, "Why were the former days better than these?" For you do not inquire wisely concerning this.

Consecration

1. Thank God for the manifestation of His glory, presence and power in your life.
2. Ask God to do extraordinary things in your life as you remain diligent and submit to His will.
3. Receive grace to overcome the desires of the flesh so you may please God in all your ways.
4. Ask the Lord to open your eyes to see His coming glory beyond your current situation; ask Him to increase your faith to persevere and trust Him to the end.

Guidance & Direction

5. Thank God for the presence of the Holy Spirit and His ability to lead you into all truth.
6. Declare that your soul will find rest in God as you hear his voice and follow His leading.
7. Pray for godly counsel to help you gather the fragments and leave a generational inheritance for your family.
8. Pray for a discerning heart and the leading of the Holy spirit to enable you gather souls for God's kingdom.

Protection

9. Thank God for being the Saviour, shield and the deliverer of your household from every act of shame or reproach.
10. Pray that the angels of the Lord will go ahead of you, fight your battles and give you victory.
11. Ask the Lord to hide you and your family in His secret place and preserve you from destruction.
12. Declare God's covering over your family; claim the victory of Christ over chronic diseases and untimely death.

Gathering

13. Thank God for the opportunity to gather souls for His kingdom this year; ask Him to use you to gather souls into the body of Christ.
14. Ask God to raise kingdom financiers to support mission and outreach programs of the church.
15. Intercede for all Christians to have the burden for lost souls and the passion to seek for their salvation.
16. Ask God to reward the evangelistic efforts of the church with massive harvest of souls and confirm His word with signs and miracles.

Declaration

*I declare that my end will be better than my beginning. I affirm that as for me and my family, we will patiently serve and wait on the Lord until His glory is revealed in and through us in Jesus' name, **Amen.***

GOD WILL KEEP YOU

DAY 16 - JANUARY 24

The LORD is your keeper; The LORD is your shade at your right hand. The sun shall not strike you by day, Nor the moon by night. The LORD shall preserve you from all evil; He shall preserve your soul. The LORD shall preserve your going out and your coming in From this time forth, and even forevermore. (Psalm 121:5-8)

Morning Reflection

Psalm 121:2-8

My help comes from the Lord, Who made heaven and earth. He will not allow your foot to be moved; He who keeps you will not slumber. Behold, He who keeps Israel. Shall neither slumber nor sleep. The Lord is your keeper; The Lord is your shade at your right hand. The sun shall not strike you by day, Nor the moon by night. The Lord shall preserve you from all evil; He shall preserve your soul. The Lord shall preserve your going out and your coming in from this time forth, and even forevermore.

Consecration

1. Thank God for opening the heavens over your life in this season of consecration and increase.
2. Pray for grace to submit your desires and ambitions to God's ordained plan for your life.
3. Commit your ways to the Lord; ask Him to help you trust His plan and purpose.
4. Ask the Lord to rain His favour and goodness over your life, ministry, business, and career as you surrender to His will daily.

Guidance & Direction

5. Thank the Lord for access to His presence and power to obtain assistance and direction for every area of your life.
6. Pray for steadfastness and commitment to seek God's face at every point as you face life's challenges.
7. Pray for God's direction to always be at the right place, at the right time.
8. Ask the Lord to roll away every stumbling block to your promotion, advancement and elevation in Jesus' name.

Protection

9. By faith, claim God's power and strength to put to flight every enemy that stands before you.
10. Mark your family with the blood of Jesus, and decree God's protection and deliverance from every harm.
11. Surrender your life to the Lord; declare that you are under an open heaven and your life is hidden with Christ in God.
12. Ask the Lord to preserve the blessings He has given you; declare that none of your possessions shall be taken from you.

Gathering

13. Pray for a new season of breakthrough and open doors for the gathering of people into the Lord's house.
14. Declare that by the anointing of the Holy Spirit, hearts will be convicted to turn from the world to the Lord in faith.
15. Pray that believers will be filled with compassion to evangelize people within their community.
16. Ask God for wisdom and sensitivity of heart to minister to hurting people around you.

Declaration

*I proclaim that this is the acceptable year of the Lord for me. The heavens are open over my life and family. My lines have fallen in pleasant places and this is my season of harvest. I reap a hundredfold blessing for all the seeds I have sown. Doors of heavenly treasures are open to me. God's will is done in my life on earth as it is in heaven in Jesus' name. **Amen!***

PRESS ON

DAY 17 - JANUARY 25

Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain it. (1 Corinthians 9:24)

Morning Reflection

1 Corinthians 9:24-27

Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain it. And everyone who competes for the prize is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a perishable crown, but we for an imperishable crown. Therefore I run thus: not with uncertainty. Thus I fight: not as one who beats the air. But I discipline my body and bring it into subjection, lest, when I have preached to others, I myself should become disqualified.

Consecration

1. Thank the Lord for His grace that enables you to press on in faith even in the face of opposition.
2. Pray that as you wait on the Lord, you will receive fresh illumination to the pertinent questions on your mind.
3. Ask the Lord for strength to not grow weary in doing good until you have obtained your reward in your due season.
4. Declare that every stumbling block in your path, meant to hinder your progress, turns into stepping stones for your lifting.

Guidance & Direction

5. Boldly declare that the word of God will be your lamp and light as you pursue your goals this year.
6. Ask God to help you to cultivate a temperate and disciplined lifestyle in your affairs so you will not miss your reward.
7. By faith, reject deceptive counsels designed to discourage you from pursuing God's best for you and your family.
8. Pray for a renewed vision and passion in your career, and receive freshness upon any area of your life that has become stale.

Protection

9. Thank the Lord for His ministering spirits who defend and minister to you as you press on to accomplish God's purposes for your life.
10. Declare that you will escape every pit and trap of the adversary that is meant to keep you away from finishing your race and obtaining your prize.
11. Pray for the blessing of preservation on the businesses and careers of your relations; declare that they shall not collapse but experience unprecedented expansion.
12. By faith, break and pull down mental and spiritual barriers that oppose progress in your family.

Gathering

13. Ask the Holy Spirit to stir up a fresh desire and conviction for the truth of His word in the Church and among Christians across the nations.
14. Ask the Lord to release an anointing for intercession in your local assembly; pray that many will rise to intercede for lost souls into God's kingdom.
15. Commit your projects for this year unto the Lord and ask Him to enable you to see their speedy fulfilment in Jesus' name.
16. Boldly declare that in this year, you will have new opportunities, ideas, and resources and by them, gather in an exceedingly abundant harvest.

Declaration

*In this year of gathering, I let go of every weight that holds me back and I press on to obtain my prize in Christ. As I fix my eyes on Jesus, He makes me as surefooted as a deer. He enables me to stand on mountain heights. I am confident that I will not be disqualified and I will not lose my reward. I will possess my possessions in Jesus' name. **Amen!***

OBEDIENCE OPENS DOORS

DAY 18 - JANUARY 26

His mother said to the servants, "Whatever He says to you, do it." Now there were set there six waterpots of stone, according to the manner of purification of the Jews, containing twenty or thirty gallons apiece. Jesus said to them, "Fill the waterpots with water." And they filled them up to the brim. And He said to them, "Draw some out now, and take it to the master of the feast." And they took it. (John 2:5-8)

Morning Reflection

John 2:5-10

His mother said to the servants, "Whatever He says to you, do it." Now there were set there six waterpots of stone, according to the manner of purification of the Jews, containing twenty or thirty gallons apiece. Jesus said to them, "Fill the waterpots with water." And they filled them up to the brim. And He said to them, "Draw some out now, and take it to the master of the feast." And they took it. When the master of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and did not know where it came from (but the servants who had drawn the water knew), the master of the feast called the bridegroom. And he said to him, "Every man at the beginning sets out the good wine, and when the guests have well drunk, then the inferior. You have kept the good wine until now!"

Consecration

1. Thank the Lord for opening the heavens over your life in this season of consecration and gathering.
2. Ask God to endow you with grace to fulfil your aspirations and plans this year.
3. Ask the Holy Spirit to strengthen you to submit to good counsel and sound judgment; declare that through wise counsel, you will avoid the mistakes of past years.
4. Declare that by your obedience to God, you will gain favour before God and man, to affect every area of your life.

Guidance & Direction

5. Declare that you will not miss open doors before you; affirm that your steps are ordered in His will and purposes concerning your life.
6. Commit your education, career and business to the Lord; ask Him to empower you with divine strategies and guide you to new opportunities.
7. Ask the Lord to open avenues for you to accomplish your dreams and aspirations for the year; thank Him for guiding you to meet the right people to help you realise your dreams.
8. Ask the Holy Spirit to empower you to diligently obey His word; ask Him to guide you through every stage of your life.

Protection

9. Ask the Lord to arise and fight your battles for you; pray that every adversary against your advancement is defeated in the name of Jesus.
10. Ask the Lord to strengthen you with the power of His might to stand firm against the schemes of the devil.
11. Rebuke evil strongholds opposing the spread of the gospel among communities; declare an open door of opportunities for the spread of the gospel.
12. Commit every missionary into the hands of the Lord; declare that their obedience to the great commission will open doors of opportunities for the proclamation of the gospel and a massive gathering of souls.

Gathering

13. Pray against limitations that opposing your progress; affirm that every limitation meant to hinder you from experiencing a massive gathering of resources is broken in Jesus' name.
14. Ask the Holy Spirit to teach you to number your days and apply your heart to wisdom in these perilous times; declare that you will live your life in prudence as God enables you.
15. Commit your ways to the Lord and declare that in this year your actions will not lead to waste and loss.
16. Declare that the time for your upliftment has come; celebrate the Lord for great victories in your life and family.

Declaration

*God's word declares that every good and perfect gift comes from above. I declare this year that my eyes are open to see the good opportunities God has for me. I am empowered to rightly discern the times to make decisions and choices that will open new opportunities for a massive gathering of resources. I am more than able to claim and maximize every resource in Jesus' name. **Amen.***

GRACE TO COMPLETE

DAY 19 - JANUARY 27

But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me. (1 Corinthians 15:10)

Morning Reflection

1 Corinthians 15:3-10

For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve. After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep. After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles. Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time. For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.

Consecration

1. Thank God for His gift of righteousness through Christ; ask Him for grace to live a life that pleases Him.
2. Pray for grace to continually walk in obedience to God's word and His instructions.
3. Ask the Lord to help you grow your faith to live the life of an overcomer.
4. Ask God to anoint you with His power to minister and serve others faithfully.

Guidance & Direction

5. Pray for the grace, favour and mercy of God to enable you overcome every challenging situations in your life.
6. Declare that as you seek God in His word and prayer, your feet will be ordered into places of favour and honour.
7. Declare that by the grace of God, every gift and skill you have will be recognized and used to advance the kingdom.
8. Ask God to guide you on the path you should take; pray for clarity and favour in your education, career, relationship, marriage, ministry and business.

Protection

9. Declare divine preservation and exemption over your life; affirm that you are delivered from acts of wickedness and unrighteousness.
10. Bless the Lord for His mercy in protecting you from dangers you couldn't see; praise Him for being your deliverer from harm and destruction.
11. Praise God for His mercy in delivering you from despair in your difficulties and hardships; bless Him for giving you peace to overcome the spirit of heaviness.
12. Take authority over every recurring occurrence in your life contrary to God's will; declare an end to it in Jesus' name.

Gathering

13. Pray and ask the Lord for the grace to win souls and populate the Kingdom.
14. Thank God for His promise to give you a thousand times more blessing; exalt Him for His uncommon favour that will move you from obscurity to prominence.
15. Pray and declare that the grace of the Lord will continually be over the church and bring increase to every area of the church.
16. Ask the Lord to raise missionaries to take the gospel to every nation in the world, and pronounce the success of every evangelistic campaign.

Declaration

*I declare that every stronghold in my life is cast out in Jesus' name. Every limitation that stands in my way is removed. As I work, I prosper in all I do. My capacity increases daily because of the grace of God at work in my life. I am well able to complete all I begin in Jesus' name. **Amen.***

Morning Reflection

Genesis 39:2-5

The LORD was with Joseph, and he was a successful man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian. And his master saw that the LORD was with him and that the LORD made all he did to prosper in his hand. So Joseph found favour in his sight, and served him. Then he made him overseer of his house, and all that he had he put under his authority. So it was, from the time that he had made him overseer of his house and all that he had, that the LORD blessed the Egyptian's house for Joseph's sake; and the blessing of the LORD was on all that he had in the house and in the field.

Consecration

1. Thank God for the gift of life and salvation; bless Him for making you a member of His household.
2. Praise God for the opportunities He continues to bring your way; declare that whatever you decree according to His will shall be established.
3. Ask God to reveal to you habits and lifestyles that hinder you from experiencing His blessings and help you to overcome them.
4. Pray for the strength of the Holy Spirit to develop the discipline to fellowship with Him daily for counsel and direction.

Guidance & Direction

5. Affirm that God is your great provider; ask Him to lead you to discover the blessing and inheritance He has for you and your household.
6. Ask the Lord to order your steps and grant you wisdom to recognize the blessings in the opportunities He brings to you.
7. Pray that your eyes will be opened to see ways by which you can increase capacity in your field of endeavour.
8. Pray against every form of distraction and negative influence that will hinder your advancement.

Protection

9. Thank God for His hedge of protection around your life, career, business and ministry; plead the blood of Jesus as a covering, by day and by night.
10. Pray against any negative circumstance that will disrupt the manifestation of God's blessings for your life during this season.
11. Declare that you and your household are covered and protected from every attack of evil and condemnation in this season.
12. Pray against every plot of the enemy to rob you of any blessing due you in this season.

Gathering

13. Ask the Lord to help you reflect His peace and love to those who will come into contact with you.
14. Ask God for a massive outpouring of His power upon the Church and her members; declare that the body of Christ will grow mightily and prevail over the gates of hell.
15. Ask the Lord to overshadow believers with His presence; declare that gatherings will be marked by experiences of divine encounters.
16. Ask the Lord to extend His hand of mercy over the unsaved and grant you the boldness to seize opportunities to minister to them.

Declaration

*The Lord is my light and my salvation. I affirm that His blessings are my portion. His will for my life and my family is established. I am blessed and highly favoured and my steps are ordered by God. I will be at the right place and at the right time in Jesus' name. **Amen!***

Consecration

1. Thank God for the life of all those associated with you by family, work or school; ask the Lord to sanctify every person to Himself.
2. Ask the Lord to cleanse you from all unrighteousness as you wait on Him.
3. Ask the Lord to strengthen each member of your family with might in their inner man to walk in obedience to His word.
4. Ask the Lord Jesus to purify and prepare His church in expectation of His glorious return.

Guidance & Direction

5. Ask the Holy Spirit for discernment to know His voice when He speaks.
6. Ask the Lord to lead you to affirm and uphold your covenant relationship with Him.
7. Pray for the increased manifestation of the gifts of the Spirit in the Church.
8. Ask the Holy Spirit to draw and guide unbelievers into God's house in this season of prayer.

Protection

9. Ask the Lord to expose every wile and deception the enemy is fighting you with.
10. Ask the Lord to build a wall of fire around your household and protect you daily.
11. Separate yourself from every reproach in your life that ridicules your faith in God.
12. Declare over your nation; "Spare Your people, O Lord, and do not give Your heritage to reproach"

Gathering

13. Give God praise for all the miracles, signs and wonders He has prepared for you and other believers throughout the rest of the year.
14. Bless God for all His promises in His word; thank Him that his power will be manifested in your life in Jesus' name.
15. Thank God for this period of prayer; thank Him for inclining his ear to hear your prayers and for performing His word in your life.
16. Pray that God will lead you to the next level of your life; declare that you will not miss your moment of manifestation.

Declaration

*I thank the Lord for His grace and the opportunity to experience His glorious power in my life. I thank Him that all things are working together for my good as I live my life on earth. By faith, I declare that I am free from fear and anxiety and His peace reigns in my heart and mind. I thank the Lord that He is my Solid Rock and firm foundation now and forever. In Jesus' name, **Amen!***
