HELPFUL HINTS FOR FASTING

The practice of regular fasting is a normal Christian behaviour taught by Jesus. In *Matthew 6:16–18*, Jesus provided guidelines for fasting. Fasting was also practiced by the early church as evidenced in *Acts 13:2*. It has been the regular discipline of believers throughout church history.

Fasting has physical as well as spiritual benefits. It must be embarked on with spiritual commitment and wisdom. Everything should be done to the glory of God.

Do's Of Fasting

- 1. Prepare your body for the fast; cut back on food portions and eat smaller meals a few days prior to the fast.
- 2. Prevent constipation during and after the fast by eating fresh fruit and raw vegetables, fruit or vegetable juices, oatmeal, etc.
- 3. Drink lots of water when fasting.
- 4. Seek medical advice before the fast if you have any existing health conditions.
- 5. You can fast in many different ways. For example, a Daniel fast is one in which you consume only vegetables and water throughout. Pray and ask God what He will give you faith for the duration of the fast.
- 6. Have a clear target as your prayer focus. Without a vision or clear goal, the people perish. Write down your vision for the fast so you can run with it (Habakkuk 2:2).
- 7. Take time to pray and read the word. This may seem obvious, but busyness and distractions can keep you from daily devotions. Expect to hear God's voice in the word, dreams, visions, and revelations. Daniel prepared himself to receive revelation through fasting (Daniel 10:1-2).
- 8. Break your fast gradually. At this point you will need to exercise watchful self-control. Break your fast on a meal that is light and easy to digest (i.e., broth, a shredded apple, watermelon, or steamed vegetables).
- Prepare for opposition. Satan tempted Jesus on the fast, and we must expect the same. Discouragement may come but take your stand on the victory of Christ.

Don'ts Of Fasting

- 1. Avoid high-fat and sugary foods before the fast.
- 2. Abstain from strong stimulants such as caffeinated and sugary drinks during a fast, including the artificial sweeteners found in diet drinks.
- 3. It is important after a fast to control your cravings and avoid overeating and nullifying the gains made during the fast.

I am excited that you are joining me on this fast. Commit to staying the course and fasting from the beginning to the end. I believe that God's glory will envelope our nation in a supernatural way as we wait upon the Lord.

We will trust the Lord to stretch forth His hands and touch us in our personal lives, families, the church, and the nations of the world.

This year, the corporate prayer each weekday will have four bands. The first will start at 5 am and run till 8 am.

There will be a break till the second session commences from 11:30 am to 1 pm. Thirdly, there will be in-person only evening prayer

services from 6 pm to 8 pm. You can visit an ICGC assembly close by to participate in these services. Finally, we will end each weekday with our late night session of intense intercession from 10 pm to 11 pm. The

WEEK 2 GUIDANCE AND DIRECTION



LEAD ME LORD

Now therefore, I pray, if I have found grace in Your sight, show me now Your way, that I may know You and that I may find grace in Your sight. And consider that this nation is Your people. (Exodus 33:13)

Morning Reflection Exodus 33:12-16

Then Moses said to the Lord, "See, You say to me, 'Bring up this people.' But You have not let me know whom You will send with me. Yet You have said, 'I know you by name, and you have also found grace in My sight.' Now therefore, I pray, if I have found grace in Your sight, show me now Your way, that I may know You and that I may find grace in Your sight. And consider that this nation is Your people." And He said, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest." Then he said to Him, "If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here. For how then will it be known that Your people and I have found grace in Your sight, except You go with us? - 1. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you set your heart and affections on things that please God.
- 2. Ask God to give you the strength and discipline to live a life set apart unto Him.
- 3. Surrender your will to the Lord and ask Him to lead you into a deep walk of faith with Him.
- 4. Dedicate your household to the Lord; ask Him to touch each member and give them the desire to follow His leading always.

Guidance

- 5. Ask the Lord to help you discern His leading in all matters pertaining to your life.
- 6. Pray for a submissive heart to yield to the guidance of the Holy Spirit.
- 7. Ask God to order your steps according to His will; declare that you will not miss His leading.
- 8. Come against every voice seeking to move you out of God's purposes; declare that your ears are open to the voice of God only.

- 9. Thank God for giving His angels charge over you; confess that you are protected everywhere you go.
- 10. Ask God to keep for you, the blessings and opportunities He has given you; pray that you will not be denied of them.
- 11. Ask the Lord to guide your family away from every opportunity intended to bring them harm; declare that no evil agenda will prosper.
- 12. Ask the Lord to watch over your children and protect them from harm wherever they go.

I believe that the Lord guides me by His Spirit in all my ways. I affirm that through God's favor, I will find my way in every situation and possess His best. I follow His leading every step of the way on my life's journey. In Jesus' name, *Amen*.

- 25. Come against every spirit that brings confusion; declare that you will have clarity of mind and heart and nothing in your life will be wasted.

Morning Reflection Genesis 25:19-28

This is the genealogy of Isaac, Abraham's son. Abraham begot Isaac. Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah as wife, the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Padan Aram, the sister of Laban the Syrian. Now Isaac pleaded with the Lord for his wife, because she was barren; and the Lord granted his plea, and Rebekah his wife conceived. But the children struggled together within her; and she said, "If all is well, why am I like this?" So she went to inquire of the Lord. And the Lord said to her: "Two nations are in your womb, two peoples shall be separated from your body; One people shall be stronger than the other, and the older shall serve the younger." So when her days were fulfilled for her to give birth, indeed there were twins in her womb. And the first came out red. He was like a hairy garment all over; so they called his name Esau. Afterward his brother came out, and his hand took hold of Esau's heel; so his name was called Jacob. Isaac was sixty years old when she bore them. So the boys grew. And Esau was a skillful hunter, a man of the field; but Jacob was a mild man, dwelling in tents. And Isaac loved Esau because he ate of his game, but Rebekah loved Jacob.

- 22. Ask the Lord to grant you contentment and a heart of thanksgiving for all that He enables you to gather this year.
- 23. Ask God to grant you speed and acceleration in your efforts to gather resources; thank Him for blessing your efforts with fruitfulness.
- 24. Ask the Holy Spirit to lead you to people who will support your vision; thank Him for helpers of your destiny.
- 25. Declare that all is well with you and that all you need to succeed in life is released to you.

Declaration

I thank God for this season of gathering. I declare that I am led by God to locations and into partnerships that will amplify my efforts. I declare that my life and work will bring increase to the kingdom of God. I inquire of the Lord and I prosper through the divine wisdom He gives me. In Jesus' name. **Amen.**

Scripture for Reflection Psalm 27:4-5

One thing I have desired of the Lord, that will I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in His temple. For in the time of trouble He shall hide me in His pavilion; in the secret place of His tabernacle He shall hide me; He shall set me high upon a rock.

Morning Reflection Daniel 9:1-7

In the first year of Darius the son of Ahasuerus, of the lineage of the Medes, who was made king over the realm of the Chaldeans— in the first year of his reign I, Daniel, understood by the books the number of the years specified by the word of the Lord through Jeremiah the prophet, that He would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem. Then I set my face toward the Lord God to make request by prayer and supplications, with fasting, sackcloth, and ashes. And I prayed to the Lord my God, and made confession, and said, "O Lord, great and awesome God, who keeps His covenant and mercy with those who love Him, and with those who keep His commandments, we have sinned and committed iniquity, we have done wickedly and rebelled, even by departing from Your precepts and Your judgments. Neither have we heeded Your servants the prophets, who spoke in Your name to our kings and our princes, to our fathers and all the people of the land. O Lord, righteousness belongs to You, but to us shame of face, as it is this day—to the men of Judah, to the inhabitants of Jerusalem and all Israel, those near and those far off in all the countries to which You have driven them, because of the unfaithfulness which they have committed against You.

Consecration

- 1. Glorify the name of God for His word that cleanses us, as we read and meditate on it.
- 2. Ask for God hunger to search His word daily.
- 3. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you understand His word as you study it.
- 4. Ask the Lord to mould you into the image of Christ as apply yourself to study His word.

Guidance

- Thank God for His leading and direction; pray that your steps will be ordered as you follow God's word.
- 6. Speak the word of the Lord over every disorder in your life; declare that the light from God's word will bring clarity in Jesus' name.
- 7. Pray that every word spoken concerning your life will be accomplished.
- 8. Declare that God's perfect will alone will be done in your life.

- 9. Thank God for His unfailing protection for your life and family.
- 10. Pray that the covering of the Lord will be over all you possess; affirm that nothing that belongs to you will be destroyed.
- 11. Pray that the mighty hand of God over you will give you grace to outrun your enemies.
- 12. Ask the Lord to deliver you from every scheme of the devil.

I declare that the word of God is alive in me. By faith I live by His commands in my heart and enjoy protection from all harm and destruction. My steps are ordered by the Lord into ripe fields and I am like a tree planted by the waters that bear fruit in season. In Jesus' name. **Amen.**

- 22. Thank the Lord for the rich harvest you are gathering and will continue to gather till the end of the year.
- 23. Ask God to direct your paths in new fields in your pursuits; thank God for opportunities to gather in a harvest.
- 24. Pray for courage to launch out into the deep and chart new paths you have never walked before, in your life.
- 25. Ask God to help you build the capacity to gather and preserve the harvest He is bringing.

Declaration

I thank God for the work of my hands. All my lines are falling in pleasant places. The Lord will establish me as I live my life by His word and enable me to be fruitful and multiply. All that has been laid up for me will not be withheld from me. In Jesus' name, **Amen.**

Scripture for Reflection Ezra 7:8-10

And Ezra came to Jerusalem in the fifth month, which was in the seventh year of the king. On the first day of the first month he began his journey from Babylon, and on the first day of the fifth month he came to Jerusalem, according to the good hand of his God upon him. For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the Law of the Lord, and to do it, and to teach statutes and ordinances in Israel.

Morning Reflection Acts 9:10 - 19

Now there was a certain disciple at Damascus named Ananias; and to him the Lord said in a vision, "Ananias." And he said, "Here I am, Lord." So the Lord said to him, "Arise and go to the street called Straight, and inquire at the house of Judas for one called Saul of Tarsus, for behold, he is praying. And in a vision he has seen a man named Ananias coming in and putting his hand on him, so that he might receive his sight." Then Ananias answered, "Lord, I have heard from many about this man, how much harm he has done to Your saints in Jerusalem. And here he has authority from the chief priests to bind all who call on Your name." But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a chosen vessel of Mine to bear My name before Gentiles, kings, and the children of Israel. For I will show him how many things he must suffer for My name's sake." And Ananias went his way and entered the house; and laying his hands on him he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you came, has sent me that you may receive your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit." Immediately there fell from his eyes something like scales, and he received his sight at once; and he arose and was baptized. So when he had received food, he was strengthened. Then Saul spent some days with the disciples at Damascus.

Consecration

- 1. Thank God that in Christ, you have been delivered from the power of sin.
- 2. Ask the Lord to help you resist worldliness and live a life of godliness that honors Him.
- 3. Ask the Lord to cleanse your heart and mind from all corrupt imaginations.
- 4. Declare that you and your household will live according to godly counsel.

Guidance

- 5. Pray that your spirit will be sensitive and obedient to the voice of the Lord.
- 6. Pray that you would not lean on your own understanding as you walk with God, but that you will wholly depend on Him.
- 7. Pray that your convictions in life will be founded on the Word of God.
- 8. Ask the Lord to help you live purposefully each day and redeem the time He gives you on earth.

Morning Reflection Mark 2:1-12

And again He entered Capernaum after some days, and it was heard that He was in the house. Immediately many gathered together, so that there was no longer room to receive them, not even near the door. And He preached the word to them. Then they came to Him, bringing a paralytic who was carried by four men. And when they could not come near Him because of the crowd, they uncovered the roof where He was. So when they had broken through, they let down the bed on which the paralytic was lying. When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven you." And some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts, "Why does this Man speak blasphemies like this? Who can forgive sins but God alone?"But immediately, when Jesus perceived in His spirit that they reasoned thus within themselves, He said to them, "Why do you reason about these things in your hearts? Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Arise, take up your bed and walk'? But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins"—He said to the paralytic, "I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house." Immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went out in the presence of them all, so that all were amazed and glorified God, saying, "We never saw anything like this!"
