HELPFUL HINTS FOR FASTING

*The practice of regular fasting is a normal Christian behaviour taught by Jesus. In **Matthew 6:16–18**, Jesus provided guidelines for fasting. Fasting was also practiced by the early church as evidenced in **Acts 13:2**. It has been the regular discipline of believers throughout church history.*

Fasting has physical as well as spiritual benefits. It must be embarked on with spiritual commitment and wisdom. Everything should be done to the glory of God.

Do's Of Fasting

1. Prepare your body for the fast; cut back on food portions and eat smaller meals a few days prior to the fast.
2. Prevent constipation during and after the fast by eating fresh fruit and raw vegetables, fruit or vegetable juices, oatmeal, etc.
3. Drink lots of water when fasting.
4. Seek medical advice before the fast if you have any existing health conditions.
5. You can fast in many different ways. For example, a Daniel fast is one in which you consume only vegetables and water throughout. Pray and ask God what He will give you faith for the duration of the fast.
6. Have a clear target as your prayer focus. Without a vision or clear goal, the people perish. Write down your vision for the fast so you can run with it (**Habakkuk 2:2**).
7. Take time to pray and read the word. This may seem obvious, but busyness and distractions can keep you from daily devotions. Expect to hear God's voice in the word, dreams, visions, and revelations. Daniel prepared himself to receive revelation through fasting (**Daniel 10:1–2**).
8. Break your fast gradually. At this point you will need to exercise watchful self-control. Break your fast on a meal that is light and easy to digest (i.e., broth, a shredded apple, watermelon, or steamed vegetables).
9. Prepare for opposition. Satan tempted Jesus on the fast, and we must expect the same. Discouragement may come but take your stand on the victory of Christ.

Don'ts Of Fasting

1. Avoid high-fat and sugary foods before the fast.
2. Abstain from strong stimulants such as caffeinated and sugary drinks during a fast, including the artificial sweeteners found in diet drinks.
3. It is important after a fast to control your cravings and avoid overeating and nullifying the gains made during the fast.

I am excited that you are joining me on this fast. Commit to staying the course and fasting from the beginning to the end. I believe that God's glory will envelope our nation in a supernatural way as we wait upon the Lord.

40 Days of Power is with us once again. We have traveled halfway through 2023, and it is that time of the year when we consecrate ourselves unto the Lord and seek His face with fasting and prayer. This annual, 40-day commitment is an important feature on the calendar of the International Central Gospel Church, and it has also become an important spiritual journey for several people around the world.

God continues to shower His grace and mercy upon His people as they call upon Him in corporate prayer. From the experiences of people in Bible times through to present day, His response to consecration and prayer remains the same – He hears from heaven, He forgives their sin, and He heals their land (2 Chronicles 7:14). So year after year, we record testimony after testimony of lives that have been touched with the joy of salvation, healing, deliverance, and total transformation as they join in prayer. Men, women, and children alike share these joy-inspiring testimonies.

40 Days of Power this year starts from Thursday, 22nd June 2023, and ends on Monday, 31st July 2023. Members of ICGC and Christians across the globe will fast and pray. We will trust the Lord to stretch forth His hands and touch us in our personal lives, families, the church, and the nations of the world.

This year, the corporate prayer each weekday will have four bands. The first will start at 5 am and run till 8 am. There will be a break till the second session commences from 11:30 am to 1 pm. Thirdly, there will be in-person only evening prayer services from 6 pm to 8 pm. You can visit an ICGC assembly close by to participate in these services. Finally, we will end each weekday with our late night session of intense intercession from 10 pm to 11 pm. The late-night prayer sessions were a great blessing to the many who tuned in and prayed along last year.

Each year, we provide this prayer guide to help participants pray in a guided, effective, and expansive manner. Weekly themes and daily sub-themes with accompanying scriptures have been outlined to ground our prayers. Scriptures are given for morning and evening reflections, and prayer segments are divided into consecration, guidance, protection, global missions, work and career, and gathering. There are also scripturally-founded declarations to affirm each day as we pray. This guide will enrich your fasting and prayer experience.

As you fast, commit to doing so wisely and healthily for the physical and spiritual benefits that are to be gained. Some helpful tips on effective fasting have been included in the guide.

2023 is our year of Gathering in ICGC. As we embark on this spiritual journey together, may we gather every fragment due us, and may no treasure of ours be lost.

May the Lord hear your prayers and answer them speedily!

GATHER THE FRAGMENTS

So when they were filled, He said to His disciples, "Gather up the fragments that remain, so that nothing is lost." (John 6:12)

DAY 33 - JULY 24

Morning Reflection

John 6:4-13

Now the Passover, a feast of the Jews, was near. Then Jesus lifted up His eyes, and seeing a great multitude coming toward Him, He said to Philip, "Where shall we buy bread, that these may eat?" But this He said to test him, for He Himself knew what He would do. Philip answered Him, "Two hundred denarii worth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may have a little." One of His disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, said to Him, "There is a lad here who has five barley loaves and two small fish, but what are they among so many?" Then Jesus said, "Make the people sit down." Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand. And Jesus took the loaves, and when He had given thanks He distributed them to the disciples, and the disciples to those sitting down; and likewise of the fish, as much as they wanted. So when they were filled, He said to His disciples, "Gather up the fragments that remain, so that nothing is lost." Therefore they gathered them up, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves which were left over by those who had eaten.

Consecration

1. Commit your ways to the Lord, ask Him to help you trust His plan and purpose for your life.
2. Pray for grace to maintain a pure conscience before God; commit your thoughts, words and actions to Him.
3. Resist negative and defiling thoughts of sin that hinder your spiritual growth.
4. Declare by faith that you are a vessel of honour for good works in your church, community and nation.

Guidance

5. Thank God for leading you into a massive harvest as you wait on him in these 40 days of
6. Power.
7. Ask the Lord to grant you the spirit of wisdom, obedience and humility as you walk according to His will.
8. Pray for wise counselors who will aid you in gathering every fragment in your life.
9. Pray for your family to open up to good counsel and sound judgment; declare that your generation will not repeat the mistakes of your fathers.

Protection

10. Ask the lord to preserve the fragments that remain in your life, declare that none shall be lost.
11. Ask God to deliver you from wasteful relationships; declare your liberty from every unbeneficial association.
12. Ask God to secure your harvests from destruction and turn your liabilities into advantages.
13. Boldly decree that your family and loved ones are secured by God's angelic protection.



Declaration

In the name of Jesus, I gather financial abundance in my life. I am consecrated to show forth God's glory and power. I receive wisdom to gather up all the fragments in my life. From today, I declare that my steps are ordered into a massive harvest for a glorious life in Jesus' name. Amen.

14. Pray for divine provision and supply of resources for the efficient running of churches in **Slovenia**.
15. Pray for missionaries in **Solomon Islands**; ask the Lord to preserve, protect and empower them to continue to preach the gospel.
16. Take authority over cultural beliefs, norms and practices that are contrary to the purposes of God for His church in **Somalia**; pull them down in Jesus' name.
17. Command every spirit of unbelief and fear operating against the believers in **South Sudan** to be silenced.

Work and Career

18. Thank God for your work and career; declare that His grace shall lift you up higher in Jesus' name.
19. Release God's power over your career; declare that every fragmented piece in your work will come back together.
20. Commit your career needs to the Lord and ask for His intervention for upliftment.
21. Entrust your work to God; declare that your eyes shall be opened to new opportunities and your mind shall conceive new ideas.

Gathering

22. Thank God for every kind of favor that has come your way so far.
23. Ask the Lord to strengthen you to continue to persist until you accomplish every aspiration.
24. Declare an end to every form of barrenness in your life; declare that you have entered into your season of gathering and massive harvest.
25. Ask the Lord to increase your financial ability; pray that you will be a financial asset to His kingdom.

Declaration

As the Lord lives, I declare that I have wisdom to gather. I declare over my life the strength to build capacity. The Lord of Host is my guide; therefore, I shall not lack any good thing necessary for a glorious life in Jesus' name. Amen.



Scripture for Reflection
Exodus 16:17-19

Then the children of Israel did so and gathered, some more, some less. 18 So when they measured it by omers, he who gathered much had nothing left over, and he who gathered little had no lack. Every man had gathered according to each one's need. 19 And Moses said, "Let no one leave any of it till morning."

Declaration

DAY 34 - JULY 25

Morning Reflection

Scripture: John 10:14-18

I am the good shepherd; and I know My sheep, and am known by My own. As the Father knows Me, even so I know the Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep. And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and they will hear My voice; and there will be one flock and one shepherd. "Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again. No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father."

Consecration

1. Thank God for His mercies and steadfast love which restores you to Him when you stray.
2. Pour your heart before God asking Him to help you always make your body a fitting temple for Him.
3. Ask God to enlarge your heart and grant you capacity to meditate and act on His word.
4. Boldly declare your liberty in Christ Jesus and receive grace to live free of sin.

Guidance

5. Thank the Lord for His peace; declare that His peace will guard your heart and fill your mouth with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs.
6. Pray that your heart will be softened to submit and receive instructions whenever God's word is preached.
7. Ask the Lord to nurture you to maturity in understanding and obeying His word.
8. Cast down any tendency in you to despise the voice of the Holy Spirit whenever He speaks to you.

Protection

9. Pray that the Lord will deliver you from every disgrace and shame; ask Him to bless you with peace and security.
10. Declare preservation over your family and friends from every reproach as you take new territories for the Lord.
11. Contend with any generational evil that resists progress and expansion in your family.
12. Command the straightening of crooked paths and removal of stumbling-blocks to your progress.



Declaration

*I boldly declare that the Lord God Almighty has gone ahead of me; and so I do not fear. I move forward in the power of the Lord. My tent is enlarged and my curtains spread wide. For the Lord, He is my Maker and Redeemer in Jesus' name. **Amen.***

15. Pray for the turning of hearts and minds away from sin to righteousness and godliness in **Sudan**; pray for a speedy resolution of conflict.
16. Uproot false doctrines and teachers who preach falsehood in **Suriname**.

Work and Career

17. Thank the Lord for His faithfulness and blessings; ask Him to guide you through every stage of your career.
18. Ask the Lord to help you realize your dreams and vision; declare that no evil influence shall stop you from achieving your vision.
19. Boldly declare that you are expanding and breaking new grounds in your career this year.
20. Ask the Lord to use your work as a medium to bring souls to the saving knowledge of Christ.

Gathering

21. Praise the Lord for His goodness and glory towards you and your family.
22. Confess that your faith is increasing to trust God for greater heights and exploits in life.
23. Declare that as you practice the word of God, you will see success in your affairs.
24. Rebuke every voice of discouragement dissuading you from striving to gather all that God has for you.

Declaration

*The Lord, He is God over my going out and my coming in, He takes care of every need of mine according to His riches in glory. His word is my firm foundation. I am a child of God and I walk with the assurance of coming blessings. In Jesus' name. **Amen.***

Scripture for Reflection

Ezekiel 11:16-18

Therefore say, "Thus says the Lord God: "Although I have cast them far off among the Gentiles, and although I have scattered them among the countries, yet I shall be a little sanctuary for them in the countries where they have gone." ' Therefore say, "Thus says the Lord God: "I will gather you from the peoples, assemble you from the countries where you have been scattered, and I will give you the land of Israel." ' And they will go there, and they will take away all its detestable things and all its abominations from there.

Declaration

DAY 35 - JULY 26

Morning Reflection

Mark 4:26-29

And He said, “The kingdom of God is as if a man should scatter seed on the ground, and should sleep by night and rise by day, and the seed should sprout and grow, he himself does not know how. For the earth yields crops by itself: first the blade, then the head, after that the full grain in the head. But when the grain ripens, immediately he puts in the sickle, because the harvest has come.”

Consecration

1. Thank God for granting you divine access to present your petitions before His throne of grace.
2. Present every fear, anxiety and apprehension about your future to the Lord; ask Him for wisdom to navigate each day.
3. Praise God for His renewed love for you each day; ask for grace to continue to trust Him for His daily provisions.
4. Declare that in this season, as you seek God in His word and in prayer, you will experience spiritual growth and prosper in your walk with God.

Guidance

5. Pray that as you dedicate yourself to serve the Lord, He will make you sensitive to His directions for your life.
6. Ask God for grace, to continually trust Him even in uncertainty; declare that your faith remains unwavering, and all things are working for your good.
7. Praise God for His divine promises to you. Declare that in this season, He will cause them to be made manifest in your life.
8. Declare that your steps are ordered by the Lord; pray that your thoughts and decisions will align with His will for your life.

Protection

9. Affirm that by the mercies of God, your feet are strengthened to walk on your high places; declare that you will not slip nor fall by the wayside.
10. Commit your going out and coming in into God’s hands. Speak over your family that none shall die before their time.
11. Plead the blood of Jesus Christ as a covering over everything that concerns you; ask God to keep your household from all evil and out of harm’s way.
12. Declare God’s preservation over you and your household; pray that every member’s life, ministry and business is protected.

Declaration

In the name of Jesus Christ, I decree that I walk under divine covering. My life is hidden in Christ Jesus in God. I boldly declare that all things are working for me, according to the will of God for my life. Nothing is lost and nothing wasted in my life. In Jesus' name. Amen.

15. Declare that the gates of the nation of **Syria** are opened to the Gospel; pray that the Lord will minister healing and comfort to citizens.
16. Pray for a stirring of the spirit of boldness for the Christians in **Taiwan**; pray that they will preach the gospel without fear.

Work and Career

17. Ask God to bless your hard work with results; pray for the wisdom to take initiative and be innovative in every work endeavour.
18. Ask God to breathe new inspiration into your heart and fill you with the spirit of creativity.
19. Pray for wisdom to form the right connections with the right people for business; declare that you are disconnected from the wrong influences.
20. Speak life over the work of your hands. Ask God to magnify your efforts and cause them to yield a bountiful harvest for you.

Gathering

21. Rebuke every spirit of limitation and lack and declare that you will enjoy God's abundance.
22. Ask God for divine expansion of your capacity to gather a great harvest in this season of gathering.
23. Declare that by the enablement of God, you and your household have the strength and will to possess every blessing set aside for you.
24. Pray for every soul that needs salvation in this season; declare that they will not miss their divine encounter.

Declaration

I praise You Lord God, for in your mercy, you save from sin. By Your hand, my head is lifted, my heart sings for joy. I declare that by my God, rivers open in dry places, and the earth yields its increase for me. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Scripture for Reflection

Joel 3:18

And it will come to pass in that day that the mountains shall drip with new wine, the hills shall flow with milk, and all the brooks of Judah shall be flooded with water; a fountain shall flow from the house of the LORD and water the Valley of Acacias.

Declaration

Morning Reflection

John 6:10-13

Therefore they gathered them up, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves which were left over by those who had eaten.

Consecration

1. Consecrate your spirit, soul and body unto the lord; ask God to fill you with his love and compassion for souls.
2. Ask God to pardon you for every act of negligence and irreverence for the Spirit of God.
3. Pray that God will set your life apart and extend His hand of blessing to you.
4. Ask God to shift your focus from worldly pursuits to heavenly pursuits.

Guidance

5. Pray for the spirit of obedience and humility; pray that you will follow the commands of the Lord.
6. Ask the Holy Spirit to direct you through the scriptures and teach you to access the power of God.
7. Ask the Lord to lead you towards greener pasture and satisfy the godly longings of your heart.
8. Declare that as you follow the wisdom of God, He will bless you with an overflow of his anointing and power.

Protection

9. Ask God to enable you preserve your harvest so that nothing is lost.
10. Pray and rebuke the spirit of wastage from working in your life.
11. Ask God to grant you perfect health to enjoy his blessings for your life.
12. Ask God to build a hedge of fire around all that concerns you and your family so the enemy cannot destroy it.

Declaration

I affirm that Lord is a shield for me, my glory and the lifter of my head. I declare that my ears are receptive to the voice of God and my heart is obedient to the leading of His Spirit. I shall abound in all graces and walk in supernatural protection and provision. In Jesus' name. Amen.

16. Ask God to grant the leadership of the **Timor-East** wisdom to incorporate faith in Christ into the fabric of their society.

Work and Career

17. Decree in Jesus' name, that God is bringing you an overflowing harvest through your work and career.
18. Claim the promise of God, that His goodness and mercy is drawing destiny helpers to you to facilitate your promotion.
19. Ask God to grant you wisdom and a creative spirit to make your services globally sought after.
20. Ask God to establish you as a helper to the less privileged in your family, church and society.

Gathering

21. Decree that the body of Christ is growing in influence in the nations.
22. Pray that God will reveal himself to the rulers of the nations and draw them unto Himself.
23. Pray that God will cause His favour to abound in all ICGC assemblies; pray that there will be manifestations of God's power in each assembly.
24. Ask God for supernatural supply of financial resources to all ICGC Assemblies to undertake kingdom projects.

Declaration

I magnify the Lord for his favour and honour He has bestowed upon the church. I declare that God is adding to the church an overflowing number of souls and positioning me to walk in the corridors of power in Jesus' name. Amen.

Scripture for Reflection

Luke 5: 1- 7

So it was , as the multitude pressed about Him to hear the word of God, that He stood by the lake of Gennesaret and two boats standing by the lake; but the fishermen had gone from them and were washing their nets. Then he got into one of the boats, which was Simon's and asked him to put out a little from the land. And he sat down and taught the multitudes from the boat. When he had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, "launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch" but Simon answered and said to Him, "Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless at your word I will let down the net" and when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was breaking. So they signalled to their partners in the other boats to come and help them. And they came and filled both boats, so that they began to sink.

*In this year of gathering, I prophesy that God is giving me an overflowing harvest and positioning me like Joseph to be a generational blessing to my family and the nations of the world. In Jesus' name. **Amen.***

DAY 37 - JULY 28

Morning Reflection **2 Corinthians 4:8-14**

We are hard-pressed on every side, yet not crushed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed— always carrying about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body. For we who live are always delivered to death for Jesus' sake, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh. So then death is working in us, but life in you. And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believed and therefore I spoke," we also believe and therefore speak, knowing that He who raised up the Lord Jesus will also raise us up with Jesus, and will present us with you.

Consecration

1. Thank God for giving you a measure of faith to prevail in all seasons of your life.
2. Ask God to fill you with His power in this season of consecration, to speak bold words of faith.
3. Pray that you will overcome the works of the flesh through faith in the death and resurrection Jesus.
4. Ask for the grace to remain resolute and firm in your confession and profession of the Christian faith.

Guidance

5. Thank God for his leading in all the hard moments of your life.
6. Pray for the continuous leading of His Spirit to do all He has commanded for your life.
7. Ask the Lord for an increase in your faith in Him with every obedience to His leading.
8. Pray for the strength of God to overcome every impediment of sickness, crisis, and struggles in your life.

Protection

9. By the power of positive confession, claim your victory over every challenging situation in your life.
10. Confess that none of your loved ones, friends and family will fall to the wiles of the devil.
11. Declare that the full blessing of Christ has been given you; thank Him for the blessing of the preservation of life.
12. Ask the Lord to strengthen your inner man to stand firm in the gap, in intercession for your family.

Declaration

I am equipped with the spirit of faith to take charge and overcome every opposition. I am blessed to overcome and possess all that is mine according to the working of Christ's power in me. The full blessings in Christ is mine. In Jesus' name. Amen.

21. Declare and confess that your work and career will be a source of blessing to you and your family.

Gathering

22. Pray for an increase in your capacity and strength to gather in this year of gathering.
23. Pray for the grace to locate fruitful avenues and opportunities for the benefit of your life, family and the church.
24. Declare that through the power of positive confession, you are empowered to secure your inheritance in Jesus' name.
25. Ask God to connect you to helpers in this season of gathering.

Declaration

Scripture for Reflection

2 Kings 4:18-26

Morning Reflection

Exodus 15:1-10

Pharaoh's chariots and his army He has cast into the sea; His chosen captains also are drowned in the Red Sea. The depths have covered them; they sank to the bottom like a stone. "Your right hand, O Lord, has become glorious in power; your right hand, O Lord, has dashed the enemy in pieces. And in the greatness of Your excellence You have overthrown those who rose against You; You sent forth Your wrath; It consumed them like stubble. And with the blast of Your nostrils the waters were gathered together; the floods stood upright like a heap; the depths congealed in the heart of the sea. The enemy said, 'I will pursue, I will overtake, I will divide the spoil; my desire shall be satisfied on them. I will draw my sword, My hand shall destroy them.' You blew with Your wind, The sea covered them; They sank like lead in the mighty waters.
