Fresh Start this year starts from Monday, 13th January 2025 and ends on Sunday 2nd February 2025. This prayer guide has been purposefully prepared to guide our prayers within the period. There are themes for each day with accompanying prayer points drawn from these daily themes.

In-person prayer services will be held at ICGC local assemblies every evening from Monday to Friday at scheduled times. A Fresh Start All-Night prayer service will be held on Friday 31st January from 10pm - 4:30am at all ICGC assemblies. Join an assembly near you and participate with others in corporate prayer in this season.

God has given us a FRESH START this year. Join me and the ICGC family on this exciting journey as we seek the face of the Lord and pray for His will to be done on earth as it is in heaven.

DAY 1 - JANUARY 13

Morning Reflection

John 1:1-5

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

Consecration

1. Thank God for the blessing of life and strength He has given you to live in this new year.
2. Thank the Lord for a fresh outpouring of His grace to live for Him; affirm that your life is dedicated to His glory.
3. Praise God for the blessedness of walking in righteousness; affirm your commitment to follow the way of Christ to please the Father at all times through obedience.
4. Ask the Lord to help you overcome every desire and temptation to sin; thank Him for victory in Jesus' name.

Guidance & Direction

5. Praise God that Jesus was in the beginning as the Word; thank Him for the guidance He is able to give you because He knows all things from the beginning and into eternity.
6. Confess your absolute trust in the wisdom and power of God; declare that without Him you can do nothing.
7. Thank the Lord for the blessings that will be manifested in your life and family this year; affirm that because all things were made through Him, your blessings will manifest through Him.
8. Ask God to help you discern the leading of His Spirit in all your pursuits this year.

Protection

9. Thank God that because He forever lives as the Eternal Word, He is present with you at all times to preserve you.
10. Affirm that God has commanded His angels concerning you and your family's protection; declare that you will be rescued from all evil and wickedness this year.
11. Thank God that by the authority in Jesus' name you can bind and loose; by faith command

every door that leads to destruction to be closed and every door that leads to blessing to be opened.

12. Praise God that His word will be a guiding light for you through every valley of darkness in 2025.

Jesus

13. Praise God for the theme of "Jesus" for the year 2025; thank Him for the understanding He will grant you about the person of Christ as you study about Him.
14. Ask God to deepen your faith in His love and promises to you in His word; pray for a greater conviction of all He has done for you through Christ.
15. Thank God for the invitation He has given to all people to be members of His family through Christ; praise Him for the opportunity to be a child of God.
16. Pray that the message of Christ will be preached with power and clarity in the world; thank God that many will run to Jesus for salvation.

Declaration

*I affirm that in the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. I affirm that Jesus is the Word and He is my Lord and Saviour. This is my Jesus year; it is a blessed and prosperous year. In Jesus' name. **Amen.***



THE WORD BECAME FLESH

DAY 2 - JANUARY 14

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. (John 1:14)

Morning Reflection

John 1:14-18

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. John bore witness of Him and cried out, saying, "This was He of whom I said, 'He who comes after me is preferred before me, for He was before me.' "And of His fullness we have all received, and grace for grace. For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him.

Consecration

1. Thank God for sending Jesus to the earth to conquer sin that we may be delivered from its power.
2. Thank God that Jesus lived among men, taught and showed us the way to live a consecrated life unto the Father.
3. Ask God to empower you by His Spirit to reject darkness and sin and to live as a member of the Kingdom of light.
4. Ask the Lord to stir your heart with a love for His statutes and instructions; pray that you will delight in them and obey them.

Guidance & Direction

5. Ask God to open your eyes to behold the glory of Christ as you study the scriptures this year.
6. Affirm that you will be overshadowed by God's glory and walk in it in 2025.
7. Thank God for the good thoughts and plans He has for you; pray that every choice and decision this year will bring you closer to its fulfilment.
8. Thank God for the grace you have in Christ to walk the paths of righteousness.

Protection

9. Declare that no lie or scheme of the enemy will change your belief in the truth of Jesus' virgin birth.
10. Thank the Lord that as you walk with Him, you will walk in truth and be delivered from every deception of the enemy.
11. Affirm that Jesus is present with you by His Spirit at all times and He will never leave you nor forsake you.

12. Thank God that shame, reproach and dishonour will not come near your dwelling and that of your family this year.

Jesus

13. Thank the Lord for His faithfulness to His promises; bless Him for the Redeemer He promised in the person of Jesus Christ.

14. Praise the Lord for His excellent wisdom in the fulfilment of sending His Son to the earth in due time.

15. Ask the Lord to lead believers to live Christ-like lives in godly love, to draw the world to Himself.

16. Pray that the Spirit of Christ will strengthen and guide the body of Christ to exalt Jesus in this age.

Declaration

*I affirm that the Word became flesh and dwelt among us in time. I affirm that as I walk with Christ, I behold the glory of the only begotten of the Father and I am empowered by His grace and truth. I will fulfill God's purpose for my life this year. In Jesus' name. **Amen.***



BELIEVE IN JESUS

DAY 3 - JANUARY 15

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe. (John 11:25-26)

Morning Reflection

John 11:17-27

So when Jesus came, He found that he had already been in the tomb four days. Now Bethany was near Jerusalem, about two miles away. And many of the Jews had joined the women around Martha and Mary, to comfort them concerning their brother. Then Martha, as soon as she heard that Jesus was coming, went and met Him, but Mary was sitting in the house. Now Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died. But even now I know that whatever You ask of God, God will give You." Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again." Martha said to Him, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection at the last day." Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?" She said to Him, "Yes, Lord, I believe that You are the Christ, the Son of God, who is to come into the world."

Consecration

1. Thank the Lord for His resurrection power at work in you to live for His glory.
2. Ask God to help you live according to the tenets of His word.
3. Affirm that this year, you overcome every besetting habit and sin that draws you away from the Lord.
4. Rebuke every voice of condemnation that speaks lies contrary to God's opinion of you as revealed in His word.

Guidance & Direction

5. Ask God to strengthen your faith to believe His faithful promises in His word.
6. Pray for the courage and boldness to affirm your belief with confident obedience to His word.
7. Pray that you will grow in the knowledge of God's ways as you commit to the diligent study of His word.
8. Pray that your thoughts and ideas will align with God's purposes for your life by the leading of the Spirit of Christ.

Protection

9. Thank God that in Christ, every believer is delivered from eternal death.
10. Declare that no weapon of the enemy fashioned against your life this year will prosper.
11. Ask the Lord to preserve you and all that concerns you from harm and destruction.
12. Pray against the spirit of unbelief and doubt about the person of Christ; affirm that you will not yield to any falsehood about the Lord.

Jesus

13. Thank the Lord that He is trustworthy and true; praise Him for the truth and certainty of every statement He makes.
14. Pray for a renewed desire and commitment to seek and learn all that Jesus said in His word.
15. Thank God that Jesus is the resurrection and the life and in Him we have life and will experience resurrection when He returns.
16. Ask the Lord to anoint you with zeal for His house; pray that you will serve Him diligently this year.

Declaration

*I affirm that Jesus is the resurrection and the life; I affirm that because I believe in Him, though I may die, I shall live. I have eternal life and I will experience the presence and power of Christ in my life this year. In Jesus' name. **Amen.***



RECEIVE THE WORD

DAY 4 - JANUARY 16

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: (John 1:12)

Morning Reflection

John 1:6-13

There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. This man came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all through him might believe. He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light. That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world. He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

Consecration

1. Praise the Lord for His willingness to receive anyone that comes to Him in faith for salvation.
2. Bless God for His power to grant those who receive Him the right to become His children.
3. Pray to God for the faith to willingly and continually believe in Jesus' name.
4. Ask God for His grace to walk away from from all partnership with the workers of iniquity.

Guidance & Direction

5. Thank God that you can have the mind of Christ; pray for the ambition to think as He thinks as you read His word.
6. Thank God that Jesus is able to grant you access into places of honour and authority as He wills.
7. Declare that as you receive His word by faith, His favour will lead you to the green pastures of blessings and opportunities.
8. Pray for the humility to walk in thankfulness and appreciation for all you receive from the Lord this year; praise Him that you will experience greater blessings as you walk in gratitude.

Protection

9. Pray that breakthroughs and deliverance will be your portion as you persist in prayer in this season.
10. Affirm that you will not walk in ignorance of your rights as a child of God; declare that you will not be denied of the blessings purchased for you in Christ.

11. Pray that though you are in the world you will not be of the world; ask the Lord to help you live above the enticements and attractions of this world.
12. Commit every child and youth in your family to the Lord; pray that you will come to believe in the name of Christ and become children of God.

Jesus

13. Praise God for sending Jesus as the true light to deliver all men from the darkness of the world.
14. Bless the Lord for the miracle of rebirth for anyone that receives Christ and believes in His name.
15. Pray that in this season and this year, everyone that has rejected the message of Christ will be touched to receive Him and become children of God.
16. Thank God for His sovereign power at work in your life; pray that as you strive to honour the name of Jesus, you will be exalted.

Declaration

*I affirm that everyone who believes in the name of Jesus receives the right to become a child of God. I affirm that I have received Him as my Lord and Saviour – I am a child of God! Many will receive the Lord as Saviour this year and rejoice in their salvation. In Jesus' name. **Amen.***



LIFE IN THE WORD

DAY 5 - JANUARY 17

In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. (John 1:4-5)

Morning Reflection

John 1:1-5

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

Consecration

1. Ask the Lord to shine the light of His word in your life and reveal every darkness of sin you must confess for His forgiveness.
2. Ask the Lord to renew His strength in your inner man to overcome all sinfulness.
3. Thank God that His light in Christ overcomes all darkness; praise Him that as you follow Him you will not walk in darkness.
4. Affirm that your life is consecrated to the Lord; declare that you belong to him all the days of your life.

Guidance & Direction

5. Ask the Lord to shine the light of His counsel in every decision you make this year; pray that you will make right choices.
6. Ask God to illuminate your mind with understanding in all issues pertaining to your work; ask him to help you navigate all challenges that come your way.
7. Ask God to help you live an exemplary life that honours Him; pray that your life will be a light to others as a city set on a hill.
8. Commit all your life's aspirations for this year unto the Lord and ask Him for wisdom to fulfill them.

Protection

9. Pray for a spirit of commitment and dedication to overcome any distraction meant to oppose you in your pursuits this year.
10. Rebuke every spirit of fear that paralyzes you from taking bold steps towards your destiny; declare that you will press forward in Jesus' name.
11. Ask the Lord to shine His light and expose every plot of the wickedness against you and

your family; declare that you escape every plot in Jesus' name.

12. Thank God that your steps are ordered away from all harm and destruction this year.

Jesus

13. Thank God for the provision of life you have in fellowship with Christ; pray that God's power at work in you, will bring to life every dead situation in your life.

14. Praise God that He grants eternal life through Christ to all people that approach Him sincerely.

15. Celebrate the Lord that as the gospel is preached, the light of Christ will shine on every nation and every continent and rescue people bound in darkness.

16. Praise God that because Jesus is the same yesterday, today and forever, He will continually give life and light to people till He returns.

Declaration

*I affirm that Jesus gives life and light to all people that approach Him in faith; I affirm that His light shines in the darkness of this world and overcomes it. I have the life and the light of Christ in my life and I overcome all darkness around me. In Jesus' Name. **Amen.***



THE LIVING WORD

DAY 6 - JANUARY 18

For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. (Hebrews 4:12)

Morning Reflection

Hebrews 4:11-13

Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience. For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.

Consecration

1. Thank God that His word is living, powerful and able to convict us of sin as we read it.
2. Thank the Lord in faith that your discernment of right and wrong is being made clearer as you pray and study His word.
3. Thank God for the gift of grace to walk in humility; ask Him to touch your heart to live in complete obedience to His living word.
4. Praise God for the blessing of covenant relationship with Him through your faith and belief in the Living Word – Jesus.

Guidance & Direction

5. Thank God for His grace available to you to live as Christ lived.
6. Pray for an increase in your faith to confidently obey God's voice as He speaks to you through His word.
7. Thank the Lord for the assurance of blessings and reward as you follow His guidance, and instructions outlined in His word.
8. Affirm that you will serve the Lord better than you did last year as you grow in your faith in Him.

Protection

9. Thank God for giving you the weapon of His word to fight your battles in faith and prevail.
10. Ask the Lord to teach you how to use the two-edged sword of His word to address every situation in your life.
11. Affirm that all things will work together for your good and what was meant for evil will turn out for your good.
12. Declare that you prevail in all your endeavours as you meditate and apply God's word.

Jesus

13. Ask God to help you follow Jesus' example of desiring to listen to and obey the Father.
14. Praise God that nothing is hidden from His sight and He knows all truth; thank Him that He will vindicate you from any falsehood levelled against you.
15. Pray that you will be anointed with power as Jesus was to go about doing good, as you feed on the word of God.
16. Praise God that His word will forever be living and powerful and a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Declaration

*I affirm that God's word is living and powerful; by it I am able to discern what is right and what is wrong in God's sight. I affirm that it is the discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart; by it I will never be led astray. I am sustained by God's Spirit and His living word. In Jesus' Name. **Amen.***



THE WORD SANCTIFIES

DAY 7 - JANUARY 18

Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth. (John 17:17)

Morning Reflection

John 17:6-19

"I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word. Now they have known that all things which You have given Me are from You. For I have given to them the words which You have given Me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came forth from You; and they have believed that You sent Me. "I pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours. And all Mine are Yours, and Yours are Mine, and I am glorified in them. Now I am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father, keep through Your name those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We are. While I was with them in the world, I kept them in Your name. Those whom You gave Me I have kept; and none of them is lost except the son of perdition, that the Scripture might be fulfilled. But now I come to You, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have My joy fulfilled in themselves. I have given them Your word; and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one. They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth. As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world. And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth.

Consecration

1. Thank the Lord that He is able to sanctify you by the truth of His word.
2. Declare that you are set apart unto holiness and righteousness for the Lord.
3. Ask God for a renewal of your mind through His word to conform to His divine will.
4. Declare that your utterances are sanctified and will impart grace to your hearers always.

Guidance & Direction

5. Praise God for anointing your lips to give sound counsel and direction to others.
6. Pray that you will be intune with the Holy Spirit at all times so your words will be a blessing to those you interact with.
7. Ask God to help your remain in the centre of His will for your life at all times.
8. Thank the Lord that every proclamation in faith in accordance with His word will come to pass in due time.

Protection

9. Affirm that Jesus' intercession for you to be kept from the evil one comes to pass daily in your life in Jesus' name.
10. Thank God that you are kept by His power and nothing will pluck you out of His hands and His protection.
11. Pray that you will be able to endure every rejection and opposition because you take a stand for truth and honesty.
12. Thank God that you are not of this world; affirm that your citizenship is of heaven and mansions and thrones await you as you live a sanctified life unto the Lord on earth.

Jesus

13. Bless the Lord for giving you the name of Jesus to pray and make declarations in accordance with His word and see it manifest to His glory.
14. Pray that the eyes of your heart will be open to see and embrace the responsibility Jesus has given you to be His representative in this world.
15. Thank God that Jesus sanctified Himself your sake, that you may also be sanctified by the truth.
16. Thank God that Jesus is at God's right hand making intercession for you right now.

Declaration

*I affirm that I am sanctified by the truth of God's word. I am set apart unto God and I will order my life according to His word. In Jesus' name! **Amen.***

JESUS IS THE WAY

DAY 8 - JANUARY 20

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. (John 14:6)

Morning Reflection

John 14:1-6

"Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also. And where I go you know, and the way you know." Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way?" Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

Consecration

1. Thank God for making a way through Jesus to approach Him and be reconciled to Him.
2. Pray for divine strength to remain steadfast in your commitment to walk in alignment with His Word.
3. Ask God for grace to set your heart and affection on Him alone and remain completely surrendered to Him.
4. Ask for the enabling power of the Holy Spirit to daily submit to His sanctifying work and to continuously grow in godliness.

Guidance & Direction

5. Pray for the commitment to continually seek the Lord for the way you should go in all your endeavours
6. Pray to God to grant you clarity and focus in all your pursuits.
7. Pray that your heart will be sensitive and humble to hear and accept the truth.
8. Ask God for a deep awareness of His presence with you in every place and in every situation this year.

Protection

9. Reject all thoughts from the enemy that make you feel unworthy of respect and love.
10. Pray for the Lord's help to value your unique qualities and the revelation to see their significance in fulfilling your destiny.
11. Intercede for every member of your family, that their lives and actions will bring honour and blessing to the family name.
12. Give thanks to God for placing you in this generation for a unique purpose.

Jesus

13. Celebrate the Lord that He is the eternal "I am".
14. Thank God for the proclamation of Jesus as being the way, the truth and the life.
15. Celebrate God for the blessing of being able to freely approach the Father through Jesus Christ.
16. Ask for a deeper understanding of the nature of the God-head as you learn about Jesus this year.

Declaration

*I affirm that Jesus is the way, the truth and the life. I affirm that I have access to the Father through Him. By my faith in the Lord, I can approach His throne and obtain grace and mercy. I will find my way, I will discover divine truth and I will walk in divine life because Jesus is my Lord and Saviour. In Jesus' Name. **Amen.***



JESUS, THE POWER AND WISDOM OF GOD

DAY 9 - JANUARY 21

For Jews request a sign, and Greeks seek after wisdom; but we preach Christ crucified, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks foolishness, but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. (1 Corinthians 1:22-24)

Morning Reflection

1 Corinthians 1:18-25

For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. For it is written: "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent." Where is the wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? For since, in the wisdom of God, the world through wisdom did not know God, it pleased God through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe. For Jews request a sign, and Greeks seek after wisdom; but we preach Christ crucified, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks foolishness, but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

Consecration

1. Exalt God for the cleansing power of His Word; give thanks that you are purified as you meditate on it daily.
2. Praise God that in Christ we have power to live a godly, holy life unto the Lord.
3. Pray for the strength and endurance to journey toward the fullness of the stature of Christ.
4. Thank God for setting mankind apart by placing the treasure of His Spirit in earthen vessels.

Guidance & Direction

5. Pray that the preaching of Christ will be presented in simplicity across the nations.
6. Thank God that His breath will give understanding to people as they hear God's word preached.
7. Pray for the clarity of thought and discernment of heart in all you do.
8. Pray that God will send wise counsellors and faithful helpers to support you through every season of your life.

Protection

9. Pray for God's protection against untimely death; declare that His power and wisdom will sustain you to fulfil the full length of your days.
10. Pray for the working of Jesus' resurrection power to uphold you through hard times; pray that even in failure, you will rise and stand again.
11. Pray that God's hope, peace, and comfort will guard your heart through challenges and uncertainties in your life.

12. Affirm that you will follow the Lord as you remain sensitive to His guidance throughout this year.

Jesus

13. Thank the Lord for redeeming you through the blood of Jesus Christ.

14. Thank God that Christ is the power of God.

15. Thank God that Christ is the wisdom of God.

16. Praise the Lord that the foolishness of God is wiser than men and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

Declaration

I affirm that I am called by the Lord into covenant relationship with Him and to His service.

But when they had commanded them to go aside out of the council, they conferred among themselves, saying, "What shall we do to these men? For, indeed, that a notable miracle has been done through them is evident to all who dwell in Jerusalem, and we cannot deny it. But so that it spreads no further among the people, let us severely threaten them, that from now on they speak to no man in this name." So they called them and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus. But Peter and John answered and said to them, "Whether it is right in the sight of God to listen to you more than to God, you judge. For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard." So when they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding no way of punishing them, because of the people, since they all glorified God for what had been done. For the man was over forty years old on whom this miracle of healing had been performed.

Consecration

1. Praise God for the privilege He has given you to come boldly before Him in prayer.
2. Ask God to keep you humble as He emboldens you to do mighty works.
3. Ask God to cleanse you of all pride and self-righteousness.
4. Thank God for the promotion and restoration He is bringing your way as you accept and repent of your sins.

10. Ask God to deliver you from the wicked who desire your downfall.
11. Declare an end to every recurring occurrence in your life contrary to God's will.
12. Pray for God's protection for missionaries who boldly preach the gospel.

13. Pray for the commitment to be faithful and trustworthy as Jesus was on earth.
14. Pray for the determination to honour your word as God has exalted His word.
15. Ask for the grace to remain bold for Jesus even in the face of adversity.
16. Pray that Jesus will continue to raise bold people who will promote the kingdom of God.

Morning Reflection

Luke 10:17-20

Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name." And He said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven."

Consecration

1. Affirm that Jesus is your Lord and personal Saviour.
2. Thank God for giving you victory through Christ Jesus.
3. Pray that as you consecrate yourself to the Lord, you will see the salvation of your God.

13. Bless the Lord for His victory on the cross over sin and the grave.
14. Pray that through the authority of Jesus, the church will rise to higher heights.
15. Boldly confess that Jesus has subdued the power of the enemy under your feet.
16. Praise the Lord for being a prayer answering God.

Declaration

*I affirm that in Christ, I have authority to enforce His victory in every area of my life. I affirm that nothing shall by any means hurt me. I shall be victorious in battle; I shall receive what the Lord has prepared for me. In Jesus' name. **Amen.***

13. Praise the Lord that 2025 is your Jesus year; thank Him that you will grow in your relationship with Him daily this year.
14. Thank God for the past days of prayer; thank Him for speedy answers.
15. Glorify Jesus for setting you free from what held you bound in the past.
16. Celebrate God for His enabling power to live victoriously in 2025; affirm that you will testify of His goodness this year.
