SCRIPTURE FOR REFLECTION

Matthew 16:13-20 When Jesus came into the region of Caesarea Philippi, He asked His disciples, saying, "Who do men say that I, the Son of Man, am?" 14 So they said, "Some say John the Baptist, some Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." 15 He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" 16 Simon Peter answered and said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." 17 Jesus answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in heaven. 18 And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it. 19 And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

CONSECRATION

- 1) Bless the Lord for the authority you have in Christ Jesus to bind and loose; boldly declare that you are the head and not the tail.
- 2) Surrender your life totally to God and ask Him to help you to step out in authority and excel in your life, ministry, career and education.
- 3) Ask God to help you to renew your mind, thoughts and ideas from worldly things and set them on things that please and glorify Him.
- 4) Pray that as you wait on God in this season of Fresh Start, your strength will be renewed to faithfully run the race of your life in accordance with His Word.

GUIDANCE

- 5) Ask God to expand your capacity in every area of your life; pray for tenacity to boldly pursue the plans He reveals to you.
- 6) Ask the Lord to guide you through the scriptures and reveal His love and His desire for you to expand on every side.
- 7) Ask the Lord to help you live by faith in His word and not by what you see; pray that the Lord will cause you to win in every area of your life.
- 8) Bless the LORD for giving you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; declare that whatever you bind on earth is bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth is loosed in heaven.

PROTECTION

- 9) Come against every plot of the enemy to keep you from exercising your authority to bind and loose in Jesus' name.
- 10) Take authority over every recurring negativity in your life, mention them and declare they come to an end in Jesus' name.
- 11) Ask the Lord to guard your thoughts and your tongue against negative utterances; pray that your tongue will become an instrument of your restoration and establishment.
- 12) Ask God to watch over your family and keep safe all He has blessed you with; declare that God's blessing of expansion will touch every member of your household.

WORK, CAREER AND EDUCATION

- 13) Ask the Lord for boldness to step out of your comfort zone to do more in your life, ministry, career and education.
- 14) Pray that as you wait on God this year, your strength shall be renewed and you will run the race of your life; declare that you will experience victory and overflow in your work, career and education.
- 15) Ask God to help you to walk in His plans for your life; pray for the grace to overcome every negative situation that confronts you at work or in school in Jesus' name.
- 16) Thank God for His will and good plans for your work, career, business, education and any other endeavour of your life.

KINGDOM

- 17) Pray and ask the Lord to expand your territory; declare that you are regaining everything that you have lost over the years.
- 18) Pray that your growth in the Lord will be evident in this kingdom year; declare that you are increasing in your spiritual disciplines and your knowledge of God.
- 19) Pray that your passion to know God will increase; declare that there will be an overflow of the blessings of the Lord as you endeavour to know Him.
- 20) Pray that in this kingdom year, the Lord will cause you to be a thousand times better than you were last year.
- 21) Thank God for hearing us and answering our prayers in Jesus' name. Declare that in this kingdom year, the lines will fall for you in pleasant places.

Declaration

*Lord, I thank You that it is Your will for me to expand to the left and to the right, forward and backward. In the name of Jesus, I declare that every stronghold in my life is pulled down and every limitation opposing my progress is removed. Philippians 3:12-14 Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me. 13 Brethren, I do not count myself to have [b]apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, 14 I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

SCRIPTURE FOR REFLECTION

Colossians 3:12-17 Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; 13 bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. 14 But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection. 15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful. 16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. 17 And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

CONSECRATION

- 1) Bless the Lord for delivering you from sin and boldly declare that you are set apart for His glory.
- 2) Declare by faith that the power of sin is broken over your life.
- 3) Pray that as you devote yourself to prayer and meditation during this season of consecration, God will fill your heart with His love, peace, and confidence.
- 4) Thank God for the privilege to worship and fellowship in His presence.

GUIDANCE

- 5) Ask God to teach you how to relate to Him as your Shepherd and to seek His voice daily.
- 6) Pray that God will order your steps from traps that would lead you to compromise your faith.
- 7) Speak boldly to the mountains in your path that they would be displaced into the sea. Pray that Jesus will be at the centre of everything you do, in word or deed.
- 8) Pray that every chaotic situation in your life and family will be turned around into good and merciful encounters.

PROTECTION

- 9) Ask God to arise in every area of your life and family. Pray that every assembly of the wicked, plotting to oppose your progress and that of your family will be scattered in Jesus' name.

- 10) Pray that God will preserve and deliver the church from every attack of the enemy; affirm that His church will be established and the gates of hell will not prevail against it.
- 11) Ask the Lord to guide you from making choices that end in harm and destruction. Break the hold of any sickness and disease over your life and declare that it is broken by the power of God in Jesus' name.
- 12) Declare that you are the elect of God in Christ Jesus, therefore no power of the enemy targeted against you shall prosper.

- 13) Thank God for the wisdom to build a successful career, ministry, or business to the glory of His name.
- 14) Declare that regardless of challenges and hardships that may come up in your work, career or education, you will grow in leaps and bounds.
- 15) Ask God to reveal the secrets of profit-making and generational wealth creation to you.
- 16) Pray that the Lord will empower struggling businesses of Christians in the church and move them to a place of profitability.

KINGDOM

- 17) Thank God for the grace to live under the authority of His Word and to fully please Him in all your ways. Thank Him for illuminating your heart through His Word and guiding you to walk in kingdom authority.
- 18) Ask the Lord to help you to know Him more and to conform to the image of Christ in this kingdom year.
- 19) Ask God to raise missionaries for nations and communities without the gospel. Pray that the Holy Spirit will lead you to the right places and people to share the gospel throughout this kingdom year
- 20) Intercede for every church member to draw nearer and nearer to God and become rooted in sound biblical doctrine. Declare that as you advance in Jesus' name, He will use you as a channel of blessing to others.
- 21) Thank God for hearing us and answering our prayers in Jesus' name. Declare that in this kingdom year, the lines will fall for you in pleasant places.

Declaration

Luke 10:8-9, 17-19 Whatever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you. 9 And heal the sick there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.' 17 Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name." 18 And He said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. 19 Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

SCRIPTURE FOR REFLECTION

Mark 16:14-20 Later He appeared to the eleven as they sat at the table; and He rebuked their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they did not believe those who had seen Him after He had risen. 15 And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. 17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover." 19 So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God. 20 And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word through the accompanying signs. Amen.

CONSECRATION

- 1) Confess your sins and ask God to forgive you and give you another chance to walk blamelessly in His sight.
- 2) Bless the Lord for setting you apart for signs and wonders; proclaim that you will continually be an instrument of the Lord.
- 3) Declare a mighty move of God in this season of consecration; pray that God will use you to advance His kingdom.
- 4) Commit yourself and your family to God, and pray for a complete turnaround of everything that opposes His purposes. Declare that signs and wonders will follow you and your generation throughout this kingdom year.

GUIDANCE

- 5) Commit your ways to the Lord and ask Him to help you make decisions in conformity to His word.
- 6) Pray and ask God to guide you and help you continually seek His presence through every changing season of life.
- 7) Commit your mind to the Lord and ask Him to free you from any memory that holds you captive. Declare that you have a sound mind to pursue your God-given purpose.
- 8) Ask the Lord to help you trust His direction and purpose for your life; receive grace from the Lord to walk in signs and wonders.

PROTECTION

- 9) Rebuke the forces of darkness designed to derail your walk in God's power; ask the Lord to send His angels to contend against every force that seeks to hinder the fulfillment of His word.
- 10) Pray that the Lord will protect your business, assets and investments and cause them to breakthrough and yield massive returns.
- 11) Ask God for wisdom to fight the good fight of faith; declare that His word will continue to inspire faith in you and cause you to trample upon every force of darkness.
- 12) Commit your ways to the Lord and declare that in this kingdom year you will walk in the wisdom and power of God in all areas of your life.

WORK, CAREER AND EDUCATION

- 13) Bless the Lord for His voice that speaks to you always; magnify Him for His wonderful works of victory and breakthrough in your work, career and education.
- 14) Ask God to go before you in every battle you face at school, work or in your career; ask Him to give you the grace to overcome every obstacle you are facing and will face this kingdom year.
- 15) Ask God to make you a beacon of excellence in your workplace and/or school, so that other believers may be encouraged to follow.
- 16) Ask the Lord to give you resounding victories and make you a witness of His blessings in your work, career and education.

KINGDOM

- 17) Ask God to empower every member of your church and help them take territories wherever they go in Jesus' name. Declare that signs and wonders will follow them throughout this kingdom year.
- 18) Ask God to raise bold believers who are devoted to the preaching of the gospel of the kingdom in every City, Province and Territory of Canada.

Joshua 14:11-13 As yet I am as strong this day as on the day that Moses sent me; just as my strength was then, so now is my strength for war, both for going out and for coming in. 12 Now therefore, give me this mountain of which the Lord spoke in that day; for you heard in that day how the Anakim were there, and that the cities were great and fortified. It may be that the Lord will be with me, and I shall be able to drive them out as the Lord said." 13 And Joshua blessed him, and gave Hebron to Caleb the son of Jephunneh as an inheritance.

SCRIPTURE FOR REFLECTION

1 Samuel 17:38-47 So Saul clothed David with his armor, and he put a bronze helmet on his head; he also clothed him with a coat of mail. ³⁹ David fastened his sword to his armor and tried to walk, for he had not tested them. And David said to Saul, "I cannot walk with these, for I have not tested them." So David took them off. ⁴⁰ Then he took his staff in his hand; and he chose for himself five smooth stones from the brook, and put them in a shepherd's bag, in a pouch which he had, and his sling was in his hand. And he drew near to the Philistine. ⁴¹ So the Philistine came, and began drawing near to David, and the man who bore the shield went before him. ⁴² And when the Philistine looked about and saw David, he disdained[b] him; for he was only a youth, ruddy and good-looking. ⁴³ So the Philistine said to David, "Am I a dog, that you come to me with sticks?" And the Philistine cursed David by his gods. ⁴⁴ And the Philistine said to David, "Come to me, and I will give your flesh to the birds of the air and the beasts of the field!" ⁴⁵ Then David said to the Philistine, "You come to me with a sword, with a spear, and with a javelin. But I come to you in the name of the Lord of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. ⁴⁶ This day the Lord will deliver you into my hand, and I will strike you and take your head from you. And this day I will give the carcasses of the camp of the Philistines to the birds of the air and the wild beasts of the earth, that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel. ⁴⁷ Then all this assembly shall know that the Lord does not save with sword and spear; for the battle is the Lord's, and He will give you into our hands."

CONSECRATION

- 1) Ask the Lord to set you apart by His Spirit and empower you to live for His glory.
- 2) Pray that the Holy Spirit will anoint you to be an avenue of salvation to your family, city and nation.
- 3) Submit your will to the will of God and ask Him to make you a vessel useful in His service.
- 4) Pray that in this season of consecration, God will anoint and empower you to take over the gates of your enemies.

GUIDANCE

- 5) Ask the Holy Spirit for discernment to know His voice when He speaks. Pray for the grace to allow the Holy Spirit to work freely and without hindrance in your life.
- 6) Ask the Lord to direct your path to possess every opportunity in this season. Pray that He will lead and equip you to overcome every challenge you face.

- 7) Pray that your heart will be opened to receive God's instruction; ask Him to grant you the strength to follow through.
- 8) Cast all your anxieties and fears unto the Lord and ask for clarity of mind in addressing them.

PROTECTION

- 9) Ask the Lord to spread His wings of protection over you and your household; declare that no attack of any giant will overpower you.
- 10) Ask the Lord to keep watch over your life and preserve your going out and your coming in.
- 11) Plead the blood of Jesus as a covering over your life and family; by faith, claim God's blessing of protection.
- 12) Declare that the Lord is your refuge and fortress, therefore no evil shall overcome you.

WORK, CAREER AND EDUCATION

- 13) Commit your work, career or education to God; ask Him for the tenacity to overcome any challenging circumstances that stifle productivity and impact.
- 14) Pray against any hindrances to your advancement in your line of work or career; pray that any giant that stands in the way of your progress is defeated.
- 15) Ask the Lord to open doors of favour and opportunity for you; declare captains of industry and strategic destiny helpers will favour your cause.
- 16) Declare the blessing of a thousand times more over the work of your hands.

KINGDOM

- 17) Pray for an understanding of God's word in ways you have never experienced before.
- 18) Ask the Lord to teach you by His Spirit to slay the giants that war against His purpose in your life.
- 19) Ask the Lord for supernatural wisdom to discern His will and His ways for your life.
- 20) Thank God for His blessings over your life; ask Him to increase you in wisdom to be productive in what you do.
- 21) Thank God for hearing us and answering our prayers in Jesus' name. Declare that in this kingdom year, the lines will fall for you in pleasant places.

Declaration

*Thank You, Lord, for the advancement of Your kingdom in the earth. I declare that these are the days of Your power, and by Your Spirit I overcome every giant before me. Any giant that rises against Your purpose for my life this year is defeated. I am divinely positioned at the center of Your will, and by Your grace I will accomplish great exploits. I declare that every giant standing against my family, career, ministry, and life is destroyed in Jesus' name.

Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?" 50 But they did not understand the statement which He spoke to them.

SCRIPTURE FOR REFLECTION

Luke 2:41-50 His parents went to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover. 42 And when He was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem according to the custom of the feast. 43 When they had finished the days, as they returned, the Boy Jesus lingered behind in Jerusalem. And Joseph and His mother did not know it; 44 but supposing Him to have been in the company, they went a day's journey, and sought Him among their relatives and acquaintances. 45 So when they did not find Him, they returned to Jerusalem, seeking Him. 46 Now so it was that after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions. 47 And all who heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers. 48 So when they saw Him, they were amazed; and His mother said to Him, "Son, why have You done this to us? Look, Your father and I have sought You anxiously." 49 And He said to them, "Why did you seek Me? Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?" 50 But they did not understand the statement which He spoke to them.

CONSECRATION

- 1) Thank God for the cleansing power of the blood of Jesus that purifies you from all unrighteousness.
- 2) Thank God for the opportunity to pursue His business. Thank Him for the privilege to serve in His kingdom.
- 3) Declare that in this kingdom year, you will walk in the power of the Holy Spirit consistently and not gratify the desires of your flesh.
- 4) Pray that as you dedicate yourself anew in this season of prayer and consecration, God will give you the grace to pursue a deeper fellowship with the Holy Spirit.

GUIDANCE

- 5) Submit all your plans and ambitions to God; ask for grace to present your life as a living sacrifice, pleasing unto Him.
- 6) Ask the Holy Spirit to make you sensitive to His leading and help you recognize divine doors of opportunity.
- 7) Pray for the strength and wisdom to promptly obey the promptings of the Holy Spirit.
- 8) Declare that as you surrender to God's will, He will grant you the grace to walk in divine wisdom, insight, and clarity.

PROTECTION

- 9) Thank God for rescuing you from the kingdom of darkness and translating you into Christ's kingdom.
- 10) Plead the blood of Jesus over your life and family and declare that you and your family are preserved from harm and evil.
- 11) Declare that you are shielded from every temptation and trap of the enemy by the wisdom of God.
- 12) Present your children before God; ask Him to protect them from influences that can pull them away from their faith.

WORK, CAREER AND EDUCATION

- 13) Ask God for grace to yield your entire educational or professional life to the Lordship of Christ. Affirm that the Lord's sovereignty is over your work, career and education.
- 14) Pray that God's glory and beauty will rest on your work, career and education. Pray for creative ideas that are God-honouring and for the boldness to act on all those ideas.
- 15) Pray that the spirit of excellence will mark all your efforts and set you apart for promotion and recognition.
- 16) Declare deliverance from stagnation, regression, and afflictions; proclaim that your path is becoming brighter and clearer every day.

KINGDOM

- 17) Speak divine wisdom and favour over your life; ask for access to new opportunities for increase and advancement.
- 18) Invite the Holy Spirit to establish a fruitful and unbroken fellowship with Jesus throughout this kingdom year.
- 19) Proclaim blessings and increase over every area of your life—family, finances, business, and ministry.
- 20) Ask for grace to remain humble and teachable as God reveals more of Himself to you.
- 21) Thank God for hearing us and answering our prayers in Jesus' name. Declare that in this kingdom year, the lines will fall for you in pleasant places.

Declaration

Covenant-Keeping God, I exalt Your holy name. You are rich in mercy, truth, and righteousness, and Your will is perfect and unwavering. From Your Word, I receive wisdom to succeed and grace to honour You with all that I am.

***John 16:33** These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.”*

***2 Corinthians 2:14-15** Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place. 15 For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.*

SCRIPTURE FOR REFLECTION

***1 Corinthians 15:50-58** Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does corruption inherit incorruption. 51 Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed— 52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. 53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. 54 So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: “Death is swallowed up in victory.” 55 “O Death, where is your sting? O Hades, where is your victory?” 56 The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law. 57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. 58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.*

CONSECRATION
