It is that special time of the year once again when we set ourselves apart to seek the Lord through fasting and prayer. I welcome you to **40 Days of Power 2026**. For many years, this annual season of consecration has been a significant spiritual journey for members of the International Central Gospel Church and many Christians around the world who join us in seeking God's face. It is always encouraging to see believers united in their desire to seek God, align with His will, and experience His transforming power. God has continually demonstrated His faithfulness during these seasons of prayer and fasting. We have witnessed testimonies of salvation, healing, restoration, divine direction, breakthroughs, and renewed spiritual strength. We will continue to hear these testimonies each year, because God is unchanging and merciful.

The theme for ICGC in 2026 is **Kingdom**. The Kingdom of God is the central message of Jesus Christ. Throughout His earthly ministry, Jesus taught about God's rule, God's authority, and God's purpose for humanity. He called people to seek first the Kingdom of God and to live according to its values and principles.

The Kingdom is not merely a future hope; it is the present reality of God's reign in the lives of those who submit to Him. Wherever God's will is embraced and His authority is acknowledged, His Kingdom is at work. As we focus on the Kingdom this year, we are learning what it means to live under God's rule and to reflect His character in every area of our lives.

This season of 40 Days of Power gives us a unique opportunity to deepen that pursuit. It begins on **Thursday, 25th June 2026**, and ends on **Monday, 3rd August 2026**. During this period, we will unite in prayer for our personal lives, families, churches, communities, nations, and for the advancement of God's purposes throughout the world.

This prayer guide has been prepared to support you throughout the forty days. It contains weekly themes and daily reflections designed to guide our prayers in a focused and meaningful way. Each day includes a Kingdom emphasis alongside prayer themes covering personal growth, spiritual renewal, guidance, protection, global missions as well as work and career life. Scripture readings, prayer points, and declarations have also been included to help you pray confidently according to God's Word.

Various ICGC assemblies will host prayer services throughout the fasting period, providing opportunities for believers to gather in corporate prayer. I encourage you to participate actively and to maintain a consistent personal prayer life throughout the season. As always, fast wisely and responsibly, taking into consideration your health and wellbeing. Helpful tips have been included in this guide to assist you in observing the fast safely and effectively.

As we embark on this spiritual journey together, may God's rule be firmly established in your heart. May His will be done in your life, and may His purposes prevail in all that concerns you. May this season draw you closer to Him and lead you into a deeper experience of His Kingdom.

May the Lord hear your prayers and answer them speedily.

HELPFUL HINTS FOR FASTING

*Fasting is a biblical discipline that helps believers draw closer to God through prayer, worship, and dependence on Him. It is not merely abstaining from food; it is intentionally setting aside physical appetites to pursue spiritual priorities. Jesus provided guidance for His followers on fasting in **Matthew 6:16–18**. The early church also fasted as they sought God's direction and power (**Acts 13:2–3**).*

Below are some helpful tips on fasting the right way.

PRACTICAL GUIDELINES FOR FASTING

1. **Cut back on food.** A fast aims to cut back on food and not just to redistribute it. Determine to eat less throughout the fasting period. This will make your body adapt more easily to the fasting routine.
2. **Break your fast wisely.** When breaking your fast, choose fruits, vegetables, soups, whole grains, and other easily digestible meals. Light and balanced diets will help sustain you throughout the fast.
3. **Stay hydrated.** Drink adequate amounts of water throughout the fasting period. Proper hydration helps maintain strength and supports healthy bodily functions.
4. **Seek medical advice where necessary.** If you have a medical condition, are pregnant, nursing, taking medication, or have health concerns, consult a healthcare professional before beginning the fast.
5. **Choose a fast that is appropriate.** There are different forms of fasting. You can opt for a complete fast for this period. You may also observe a partial fast, such as the Daniel Fast (Daniel 1:12; 10:3). Prayerfully determine the approach that best enables you to seek God effectively.
6. **Establish clear prayer objectives.** Start the fast with specific spiritual goals. Identify areas where you are seeking God's intervention, direction, breakthrough, growth, or guidance. Write these prayer targets down and bring them before the Lord consistently throughout the fast.
7. **Prioritize prayer and God's Word.** Set aside dedicated times for prayer, Bible reading, worship, meditation, and reflection. Allow God's Word to shape your prayers and strengthen your faith.
8. **Expect God to speak.** As you seek the Lord, remain attentive to His voice through Scripture, the prompting of the Holy Spirit, godly counsel, and times of personal reflection.
9. **Be watchful in spiritual warfare.** Fasting sharpens spiritual sensitivity. At the same time, you may encounter distractions, discouragement, temptation, or opposition. Stand firm in God's promises and remember that Christ has already secured the victory for us.
10. **Be Thankful.** Give thanks to God at all times and keep counting your blessings as you wait upon Him.

THINGS TO AVOID DURING THE FAST

1. **Avoid excessive indulgence.** Limit foods and habits that encourage overindulgence, particularly highly processed, sugary, and excessively fatty foods.
2. **Avoid dependence on stimulants.** Reduce reliance on caffeinated, highly sweetened, or energy-boosting drinks where possible.
3. **Minimize distractions.** Reduce activities that compete for your attention, such as excessive entertainment, social media, or unnecessary engagements. Create space to focus on God.
4. **Do not overeat when breaking your fast.** Exercise self-control at the end of each day's fasting.
5. **Do not fast merely as a ritual.** True fasting is not about outward appearance or religious performance. Let your fasting flow from a sincere heart that desires to know God, obey Him, and grow in spiritual maturity.

Determine in your heart to remain faithful from the beginning to the end of the fast. There may be moments of difficulty, but God's grace will sustain you.

WEEK 1
PURSUE CONSECRATION



CONSECRATE A FAST

Blow the trumpet in Zion, Consecrate a fast, Call a sacred assembly; (Joel 2:15)

DAY 1 - JUNE 25

Morning Reflection

Joel 2:12-17

“Now, therefore,” says the Lord, “Turn to Me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning.” So rend your heart, and not your garments; return to the Lord your God, for He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness; and He relents from doing harm. Who knows if He will turn and relent, and leave a blessing behind Him— A grain offering and a drink offering for the Lord your God? Blow the trumpet in Zion, consecrate a fast, call a sacred assembly; gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children and nursing babes; let the bridegroom go out from his chamber, and the bride from her dressing room. Let the priests, who minister to the Lord, weep between the porch and the altar; let them say, “Spare Your people, O Lord, and do not give Your heritage to reproach, that the nations should rule over them. Why should they say among the peoples, ‘where is their God?’ ”

Consecration

1. Thank the Lord for bringing you to this year’s 40 Days of Power and for the privilege of seeking Him through fasting and prayer.
2. Ask God to create in you a clean heart and renew a steadfast spirit within you as you begin this season of consecration.
3. Pray for grace to turn to the Lord with all your heart, withholding no area of your life from His lordship.
4. Ask the Holy Spirit to produce genuine repentance and spiritual hunger in you throughout this season.

Guidance

5. Ask the Lord to teach you how to seek Him rightly and align your heart with His purposes.
6. Pray that every distraction and competing affection will be removed from your life.
7. Ask God to grant you understanding of His Word and sensitivity to His voice throughout these forty days.
8. Pray that the Lord will reveal areas of your life that require correction and deeper surrender to Him.

Protection

9. Thank God for His covenant of preservation over you and your family.
10. Ask the Lord to sustain you throughout this period of fasting.
11. Pray for protection against every attack of the enemy designed to weaken your commitment to seek God.
12. Declare that no distraction, temptation, or adversity will prevent you from completing this season of consecration faithfully.

Declaration

I answer the call to seek the Lord with all my heart. As I humble myself through fasting and prayer, my heart is consecrated unto God and my life is aligned with His will. By His grace, I will finish this season stronger, purer, and closer to Him in Jesus' name. Amen.

Global Missions

13. Pray that the Church in **Afghanistan** will be strengthened and preserved as believers follow Christ in the face of persecution; ask God to reveal Himself to many through dreams, visions, and personal encounters.
14. Thank God for the growing witness of the Church in **Albania**; pray for spiritual renewal among believers and greater effectiveness in discipling the next generation.
15. Pray that believers in **Algeria** will be strengthened, protected, and emboldened to stand firm in their faith despite pressure and restrictions.
16. Ask the Lord to strengthen churches in **Andorra**, where secularism has weakened religious commitment, and pray for renewed spiritual hunger among the people.
17. Ask God to heal the nation of **Angola** from the effects of poverty, corruption, and economic hardship; pray that the Church will be a beacon of hope and transformation.

Work and Career

18. Thank God for the privilege of work and for every opportunity He has given you to be fruitful.
19. Ask the Lord to help you honour Him through faithfulness in your work.
20. Pray that your workplace will become a platform through which Christ is revealed to others through your life.
21. Ask God to prosper the work of your hands and establish every assignment He has committed to you.

Kingdom

22. Pray that the Church will respond to God's call to deeper consecration and wholehearted devotion.
23. Ask God to raise a generation that seeks Him sincerely and values His presence above all earthly pursuits.
24. Pray for salvation among family members, friends, and loved ones who have not yet come to faith in Christ.
25. Ask the Holy Spirit to ignite fresh passion for holiness and obedience among believers.

Declaration

The knowledge of the Lord will cover the earth as the waters cover the sea. The Church will arise in consecration, nations will experience God's saving power, and His purposes will prevail in every sphere of life. As I walk faithfully before Him, His favour and blessing will rest upon my work and my household in Jesus' name. Amen.

Scripture for Reflection

Ezra 8:21-23

Then I proclaimed a fast there at the river of Ahava, that we might humble ourselves before our God, to seek from Him the right way for us and our little ones and all our possessions. For I was ashamed to request of the king an escort of soldiers and horsemen to help us against the enemy on the road, because we had spoken to the king, saying, "The hand of our God is upon all those for good who seek Him, but His power and His wrath are against all those who forsake Him." So we fasted and entreated our God for this, and He answered our prayer.

Declaration

I humble myself before the Lord and dedicate this season wholly to Him. As I seek Him through fasting and His Word, He will direct my paths, strengthen my faith, and reveal His purpose for me. The hand of the Lord shall be upon me for good throughout this season in Jesus' name. Amen.



SEEK FORGIVENESS AND CLEANSING

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)

DAY 2 - JUNE 26

Morning Reflection

1 John 1:8-10

If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us.

Consecration

1. Thank God for His grace that provides forgiveness and cleansing through the blood of Jesus Christ.
2. Humbly confess every known sin before the Lord and ask Him to cleanse you from all unrighteousness.
3. Ask the Holy Spirit to search your heart and reveal anything that hinders your fellowship with God.
4. Pray for grace to walk in holiness and obedience before the Lord throughout this season of consecration.

Guidance

5. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you recognize areas of your life that require repentance and surrender to God.
6. Pray for wisdom to walk in God's ways and avoid every path that leads to compromise.
7. Ask God to guide you into a deeper understanding of His grace and transforming power.
8. Pray that the Holy Spirit will continually lead you into truth and strengthen your desire to please God.

Protection

9. Ask the Lord to expose every deception and temptation the enemy may use against you.
10. Pray that the blood of Jesus will preserve your heart and mind from defilement.
11. Ask God to strengthen every member of your family to resist temptation and walk in righteousness.
12. Declare that every accusation and scheme of the enemy against your life is cancelled through the finished work of Christ.

Declaration

I come before the Lord with a humble and repentant heart. Through the blood of Jesus, I receive forgiveness and cleansing. My heart is purified and my life is aligned with God's will. I will walk in holiness and enjoy fellowship with my Heavenly Father in Jesus' name.
Amen.

Global Missions

13. Pray for a fresh spiritual awakening in **Antigua and Barbuda**; ask God to revive the Church and raise believers who will boldly proclaim Christ throughout the nation.
14. Pray that believers in **Argentina** will be filled with fresh passion for evangelism and boldly proclaim the Gospel throughout the nation.
15. Ask God to bring healing, peace, and reconciliation to **Armenia** and strengthen the witness of the Church during times of uncertainty.
16. Cry out for spiritual renewal in **Australia**; pray that believers will return to wholehearted devotion and love for Jesus Christ.
17. Ask God to raise courageous and holy believers in **Austria** who will faithfully represent Christ and impact society with the Gospel.

Work and Career

18. Ask God to cleanse your motives and help you serve with integrity in your workplace.
19. Pray for wisdom to make righteous decisions that honour God in your career.
20. Ask the Lord to remove every barrier caused by compromise and establish the work of your hands.
21. Pray that your conduct and character at work will reflect Christ and draw others to seek Him.

Kingdom

22. Ask God to increase your hunger for righteousness and your desire to live a life that pleases Him.
23. Pray that the Church will walk in purity, holiness, and faithfulness as the Bride of Christ.
24. Ask God to bring repentance and restoration to those who have wandered away from Him.
25. Pray that the Word of God will produce lasting transformation in the lives of believers.

Declaration

The Gospel of Jesus Christ will continue to transform lives across the nations. The Church will walk in holiness. God will prosper the work of my hands as I serve Him with integrity, and His righteousness will be established in my life in Jesus' name. Amen.

Scripture for Reflection

Psalm 51:1-4

Have mercy upon me, O God, according to Your lovingkindness; according to the multitude of your tender mercies, blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. For I acknowledge my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. Against You, You only, have I sinned, and done this evil in Your sight—that You may be found just when You speak, and blameless when You judge.

Declaration

I receive the mercy of God through Jesus Christ. My sins are forgiven, my heart is cleansed, and my fellowship with God is restored. The Holy Spirit strengthens me to walk in righteousness and obedience. I will grow in grace and bring glory to God in all that I do in Jesus' name. Amen.



LIVE SEPARATED UNTO THE LORD

Therefore "Come out from among them and be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, and I will receive you." (2 Corinthians 6:17)

DAY 3 - JUNE 27

Morning Reflection

2 Corinthians 6:14-18

Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever? And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will dwell in them and walk among them. I will be their God, and they shall be My people." Therefore "come out from among them and be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, and I will receive you." "I will be a Father to you, and you shall be My sons and daughters, says the LORD Almighty."

Consecration

1. Thank God for calling you out of darkness into His marvelous light and making you His own possession in Christ.
2. Dedicate every area of your life to the Lord and ask for grace to live for His glory.
3. Ask the Holy Spirit to strengthen you to reject worldly influences and honor God in your lifestyle.
4. Pray that throughout these 40 Days of Power, your heart will remain devoted to God and sensitive to His presence.

Guidance

5. Ask the Lord to help you discern between what is pleasing to Him and what compromises your walk with Him.
6. Pray for wisdom to make decisions that reflect your identity as a child of God.
7. Ask the Holy Spirit to lead you away from every path of temptation and into deeper obedience to God's Word.
8. Pray that God will order your steps and establish you in righteousness.

Protection

9. Ask the Lord to preserve you from ungodly influences and every snare of the enemy.
10. Pray that God will guard your heart so that you remain steadfast in your devotion to Him.
11. Ask the Lord to protect your family from every attack designed to weaken their faith and commitment to Christ.
12. Declare that every weapon formed against your spiritual growth shall not prosper.

Declaration

I belong to the Lord and am set apart for His holy purpose. I reject every influence that seeks to draw me away from Him and embrace a life of obedience. The Holy Spirit empowers me to walk worthy of my calling, and my life will reflect the glory of Christ in Jesus' name. Amen.

Global Missions

13. Pray that believers in **Azerbaijan** will remain steadfast in their faith and that the Gospel will continue to spread despite religious restrictions and societal pressures.
14. Ask God to strengthen the Church in the **Bahamas** and raise passionate disciples who will impact their communities with the transforming power of Christ.
15. Pray for protection, courage, and spiritual growth for believers in **Bahrain**; ask the Lord to reveal Himself to many through dreams, testimonies, and personal encounters.
16. Ask God to sustain and encourage believers in **Bangladesh** who face opposition for their faith and empower them to remain faithful witnesses for Christ.
17. Pray that the Church in **Barbados** will experience spiritual renewal and boldly proclaim the Gospel, leading many to salvation and discipleship.

Work and Career

18. Ask God to help you maintain integrity and a Christlike testimony in your workplace.
19. Pray for wisdom to resist every unethical practice and to honor God in every professional responsibility entrusted to you.
20. Ask the Lord to distinguish you through His favor as you faithfully serve Him in your work and career.
21. Pray that your workplace will become a platform through which the light of Christ is displayed to others.

Kingdom

22. Ask God to deepen your understanding of what it means to live as a people set apart for His glory.
23. Pray that the Church will remain distinct from the values of the world and uphold God's truth.
24. Intercede for your family members and loved ones to experience transformation through the power of the Holy Spirit.
25. Ask God for fresh encounters with His presence that will strengthen your devotion to Him.

Declaration

*The Lord is raising a people who are holy and separated unto Himself. The nations will see the difference Christ makes in the lives of His people and be drawn to His salvation. My life and testimony will reflect Christ and bring glory to His name in Jesus' name. **Amen.***

Scripture for Reflection

Leviticus 20:24-26

But I have said to you, 'You shall inherit their land, and I will give it to you to possess, a land flowing with milk and honey.' I am the LORD your God, who has separated you from the peoples. You shall therefore distinguish between clean animals and unclean, between unclean birds and clean, and you shall not make yourselves abominable by beast or by bird, or by any kind of living thing that creeps on the ground, which I have separated from you as unclean. And you shall be holy to Me, for I the LORD am holy, and have separated you from the peoples, that you should be Mine.

Declaration

*I thank the Lord for making me His own possession through Jesus Christ. I am separated unto Him and empowered by His Spirit to walk in holiness and obedience. My life will not be conformed to this world but transformed by the renewing of my mind. I will honor God with my life, and His purpose for me will be fulfilled in Jesus' name. **Amen.***



SET YOUR MIND ON THINGS ABOVE

*If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.
(Colossians 3:1-2)*

DAY 4 - JUNE 28

Morning Reflection Colossians 3:1-4

If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory.

Consecration

1. Thank God for raising you with Christ and giving you a new life whose true identity is hidden with Him in God.
2. Worship the Lord for the eternal inheritance that belongs to you in Christ Jesus.
3. Ask God to set your heart on His Kingdom above earthly pursuits.
4. Pray for loved ones who have drifted from the faith; ask the Lord to draw them back to Himself and restore their passion for Him.

Guidance

5. Ask the Holy Spirit to renew your mind daily through God's Word.
6. Pray for wisdom to prioritize what is eternal and make decisions that reflect God's Kingdom.
7. Ask God to help the children and young people in your family develop a love for Christ and a desire to seek Him from an early age.
8. Pray that the Holy Spirit will strengthen you to reject worldly influences and live with an eternal perspective.

Protection

9. Ask the God of peace to guard your heart and mind in Christ Jesus.
10. Reject every influence of fear and worldly thinking that seeks to distract you from Christ.
11. Pray that every stronghold of unbelief and spiritual complacency will be broken over your life and family.
12. Ask God to preserve your household in unity and faith as you seek Him together.

Declaration

*My heart is fixed on the Lord and my mind is governed by His truth. I seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness. Earthly distractions will not control me, and worldly pressures will not move me from my devotion to Christ. My life is hidden with Christ in God, and I walk daily in His peace and victory in Jesus' name. **Amen.***

Global Missions

13. Pray that believers in **Belarus** will remain steadfast in their faith and that every restriction against the Gospel will ultimately serve to advance God's Kingdom.
14. Ask God to use the Church in **Belgium** as an instrument of reconciliation, renewal, and spiritual awakening among its diverse communities.
15. Pray that the truth of God's Word will overcome religious confusion and nominal Christianity in **Belize**, leading many to genuine faith in Christ.
16. Ask the Lord to break the influence of traditional spiritual strongholds in **Benin** and draw many people into the freedom found in Jesus Christ.
17. Pray that God will raise workers, translators, and disciple-makers in **Bhutan** so that every people group may have access to Scripture and the message of salvation.

Work and Career

18. Commit your work and career to the Lord and ask Him to help you pursue success without losing sight of eternal priorities.
19. Pray for wisdom to manage your responsibilities in ways that honor God.
20. Ask the Lord to establish the work of your hands and use your career as a platform for advancing His purposes.
21. Pray that your financial decisions will reflect trust in God's provision rather than worldly security.

Kingdom

22. Thank God for equipping you with everything necessary to live a fruitful and effective life in His Kingdom.
23. Ask for grace to remain faithful in your service to God.

DAY 5 - JUNE 29

Morning Reflection

Psalm 37:3-7

Trust in the Lord, and do good; dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness. Delight yourself also in the Lord, and He shall give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday. Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for Him; do not fret because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass.

Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints. (Jude 1:3)

DAY 19 - JULY 13

Morning Reflection

Jude 1:1-4

Jude, a bondservant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to those who are called, sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ: Mercy, peace, and love be multiplied to you. Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints. Even so the Lord has commanded that those who preach the gospel should live from the gospel. But I have used none of these things, nor have I written these things that it should be done so to me; for it would be better for me to die than that anyone should make my boasting void. For if I preach the gospel, I have nothing to boast of, for necessity is laid upon me; yes, woe is me if I do not preach the gospel! For if I do this willingly, I have a reward; but if against my will, I have been entrusted with a stewardship. What is my reward then? That when I preach the gospel, I may present the gospel of Christ without charge, that I may not abuse my authority in the gospel.

Consecration

1. Thank the Lord for the Gospel of Jesus Christ through which you have received salvation, forgiveness, and eternal life.
2. Ask the Lord to make you a vessel of honour, sanctified and useful for His purposes in advancing His Kingdom.

DAY 26 - JULY 20

Morning Reflection

Matthew 6:31-34

“Therefore do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’ For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.

Consecration

For all things are for your sakes, that grace, having spread through the many, may cause thanksgiving to abound to the glory of God. Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day. For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory, while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

STANDING FAST ON GOD'S PROMISES

He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform. (Romans 4:20-21)

DAY 28 - JULY 22

Morning Reflection

Romans 4:18-25

Who, contrary to hope, in hope believed, so that he became the father of many nations, according to what was spoken, "So shall your descendants be." And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb. He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform. And therefore "it was accounted to him for righteousness." Now it was not written for his sake alone that it was imputed to him, but also for us. It shall be imputed to us who believe in Him who raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead, who was delivered up because of our offenses, and was raised because of our justification.

Consecration

1. Bless the Lord for His faithfulness and for every promise He has fulfilled in Christ Jesus.
2. Thank God that His Word is sure and trustworthy, and that He remains faithful even when circumstances seem contrary.
3. Surrender every fear, doubt, and anxiety to the Lord; ask Him to strengthen your faith to trust Him completely.
4. Pray for grace to remain steadfast in obedience and devotion while waiting for God's promises to come to pass.

Guidance

5. Ask the Holy Spirit to teach you how to meditate on God's Word and build your life upon His promises.
6. Pray for discernment to distinguish between the voice of faith and the voice of unbelief.
7. Commit every decision and turning point in your life to the Lord; ask Him to guide you according to His perfect will.
8. Ask the Lord to help you see situations from His perspective and remain fully persuaded of His faithfulness.

Protection

9. Come against every thought, fear, or circumstance that seeks to weaken your confidence in God.
10. Ask the Lord to help you guard your heart and mind against discouragement and doubt.

Then Abram said, "Look, You have given me no offspring; indeed one born in my house is my heir!" Then He brought him outside and said, "Look now toward heaven, and count the stars if you are able to number them." And He said to him, "So shall your descendants be." So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no injury whatever was found on him, because he believed in his God.

DAY 33 - JULY 27

ASK GOD TO SHOW YOU HIS GLORY

And he said, "Please, show me Your glory." 19 Then He said, "I will make all My goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim the name of the Lord before you. I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion." (Exodus 33:18-19)

Morning Reflection

Exodus 33:12-17

Then Moses said to the Lord, "See, You say to me, 'Bring up this people.' But You have not let me know whom You will send with me. Yet You have said, 'I know you by name, and you have also found grace in My sight.' Now therefore, I pray, if I have found grace in Your sight, show me now Your way, that I may know You and that I may find grace in Your sight. And consider that this nation is Your people." And He said, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest." Then he said to Him, "If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here. For how then will it be known that Your people and I have found grace in Your sight, except You go with us?
